



2020 Mayor's Challenge Frequently Asked Questions

(Updated November 15, 2020)

Q: What is the format of this year's Mayor's Challenge?

A: Given current conditions, participants can participate in this year's Mayor's Challenge either completely virtual or through a drive-around-town scavenger hunt. More details will follow with the virtual option. For the drive-around-town scavenger hunt, parents are asked to drive their child(ren) to various locations across the city. Upon reaching each location, volunteers will provide you with directions for the completion of a health and wellness activities. At certain locations, parents will need to park and children will be asked to come out of the car to complete certain activities. Safety measures and COVID protocols will be in place. **MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN COMPLETING IN-PERSON ACTIVITIES AND SOCIAL DISTANCING FOLLOWED.**

Q: How do I register for this year's Mayor's Challenge?

Q: When does registration close?

A: Registration will remain open up to and including Sunday, December 6, 2020.

Q: I've registered for the Mayor's Challenge, now what?

A: Once you register for the event, you will receive an email thanking you for registering. Another email will follow prior to the event providing detailed instructions for participation. The in-person aspect of the Mayor's Challenge is scheduled December 6 from 8 am to 2 pm. You may participate at any time during this time frame at anytime that is convenient for you and your family.

Q: Will my participation help my school earn a monetary prize?

A: Yes. All schools that have 5% of their student population, based on total enrollment, participate and complete the Mayor's Challenger will earn a \$1,000 cash prize for their school to be used at the principal's discretion. Additionally, the school with the higher participation by percentage of enrollment will be awarded the winner of the Mayor's Challenge and be awarded with the Commissioners' Cup from the City of Weston.



Q: Can my child win a prize for participating?

A: Yes. All students that register and participate in a certain number of activities will be entered to win prizes, such as a Playstation 5.

Q: Does my child receive a free tee-shirt for participating?

A: Yes. All students that register and participate will receive a tee-shirt and potentially other free goodies. Participating students will also be eligible to participate in the Festival Raffle with the chance to win more prizes. Tee-shirts will be available before and during the weekend of December 6th. Details of how/where to pick up your child's tee-shirt will be forthcoming.

Q: If I have multiple elementary-aged children, do I need to register them individually?

A: Yes. All elementary-aged children participating in the Mayor's Challenge must be individually registered in order to be counted for their school and entered to win the prizes.

Q: Does each participating child need their own device?

A: Preferably, if you are completing the Mayor's Challenge in-person, it is recommended that each participant have their own device. However, if only one device is available, it is recommended to use multiple browsers (one browser per child) to easily access and enter their details to their specific scavenger hunt page.

Q: What is the difference between the Mayor's Challenge and the Festival?

The Mayor's Challenge is the part of the scavenger hunt that qualifies your school to win the cash prize. By completing the tasks for the Mayor's Challenge, your child will be counted toward the participation requirement and help their school earn a cash prize.

The Festival is the next component of the event. Completing the Festival activities will allow your child to earn virtual tickets that can be entered into a drawing to win prizes such as a Playstation 5.

Q: My child is not enrolled in a Weston area school, may my student still participate?

Yes, elementary students outside of the City of Weston may participate in the Festival and be eligible to win prizes such as a PlayStation 5! When registering, the student should select "Other" as their school.
