First Day of School

The first day of school is August 16th. Parents will be allowed to walk their children to their classroom door on the first day (ONLY ON THE FIRST DAY). Thank you for helping to foster their independence! We will have staff and student leaders available to assist any students who need help.

Attendance and Tardies

It is particularly important for students to be on time for school. Students are expected to be in their classroom at 8:00 a.m. Regular school attendance is important for students to be successful.

Arrival/Dismissal

We have three separate arrival and dismissal locations. <u>Bus Riders</u> use the front of the school.

<u>Walkers</u> use the gate on 69th Ave by the crossing guard. <u>Car-Riders</u> use the back car loop. Parents are to enter the car loop through Driftwood Recreation Center. For arrival, the car loop will be open at 7:30 a.m. and close promptly at 8:00 a.m. The gate will open back up for dismissal. All car riders will be given a car tag for parents to hang from their rear-view mirror with their child's full name, grade level, and teacher.

Late Arrivals and Early Dismissals

Students who arrive at school after the gates are locked at 8:00 am must be brought to the front office and signed in by the parent or guardian. Parents who wish to pick students up prior to the 2:00 pm dismissal must come to the front office no later than 1:30 pm with a government-issued photo ID. Anyone without an ID and/or not listed on the Emergency Contact Form will not be allowed to pick up the student. ALL dismissal changes must be made in writing prior to 1:30 pm. We cannot accept dismissal changes after 1:30 pm.

Breakfast and Lunch

Breakfast is served from
7:30- 7:55 am. Driftwood will operate
under the Community Eligibility
Program this year and therefore
both breakfast and lunch will be FREE
for all students! We are very excited
to be able to continue to offer this
to our community.



Front Office Procedures

The front office remains locked at all times. Please ring the doorbell on the right side of the door and have your government issued ID readily available to hold up to the camera on the top of the doorbell. Please wait patiently to be buzzed into the office. If you are visiting the campus, you will be checked in with your ID through our Rapture System and issued a visitor's pass to wear. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

Safety and Security

The safety of our students and staff is of the utmost importance. Some of our safety and security measures include having a School Resource Officer on campus and Campus Monitors. All classroom doors remain locked throughout the day. Students and staff are required to wear identification badges. All open gates are monitored by school personnel. After arrival, all perimeter gates Will be locked at 8:00 a.m. except for the front gate to allow parents and visitors access to the school. If personnel are not available to dedicate to this post, the gate must remain locked and visitors to the campus must call the school's office to gain entry to the campus.
