

- Step 6: **Sign** the printed submission form(s).

#### Parents,

As we navigate through this new process of Back-to-School Online Forms with parents we are noticing some common mistakes that are happening that's preventing parents from completing the forms. We wanted to share some of these tips and tricks in hopes that it will help you complete the forms.

- After you enter a few screens of information (mostly your emergency contact information) you will be brought to a screen that has a green bar at the bottom and says "100% completed". This is misleading because above that bar it says to check the email you entered for the link that will have you complete the rest of the forms. If you did not do this part yet, you have not completed the forms. Please check your personal email (and SPAM folder) to click the link they sent you to complete the forms.
- Once you click on the email link you will be brought to a page that looks like you are just reviewing the information you just entered, click "continue" and then it will prompt you for more information. You have to continue to enter the new information on each page before you get to the end. If you want to pause and continue filling them out later, all you need to do is go back to the link in your email and keep clicking "continue" until you get back to the page you left off on.
- Once you have completed the forms in their entirety, you will receive a confirmation code. Some have shared that the submission form isn't popping up for them or that they don't have printer to print these sheets. If either are the case, please take a picture of or write down the confirmation code and email it to jennifer.mcgreevy@browardschools.com. Mrs. McGreevy will then give you a hard copy of the form to fill out and sign.
- Your signature on the Submission Form is important because that is how we verify that you are the person that completed these forms for your child(ren).
- If your child has a hyphenated last name or two last names you will need to enter both of those last names before it will let you move forward. Some people are seeing an error message that states "your child cannot be found", this may be because the last name didn't match exactly what we have in the system.
- When it asks you for your "house number" it is not the Home Phone Number, it's the actual number of your house/apt/address. For instance 1250 Nob Hill the house number would be "1250".

If you think you have turned in your forms but aren't sure, please call the school and we can quickly check to see if you have submitted the submission form. You can also visit the school between 10:30-11:15 any day for assistance.

Remember if you have not completed these forms yet, it is imperative that you do so as soon as possible. The website is below.
