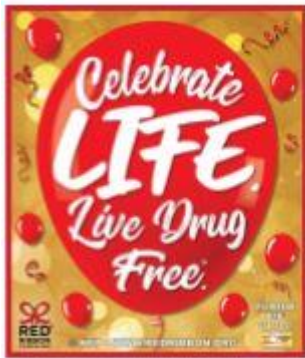


# Heron Heights Elementary Celebrates
