### Eligibility Requirements

- Early Head Start accepts pregnant women and children birth to 3-years-old.
- Head Start accepts children 3-or 4-years-old on or before **September 1, 2020**.
- Families with income below Federal Poverty Guidelines, receiving public assistance, homeless, foster children, and children with disabilities are eligible.

\*Completing the pre-application ***does not*** guarantee your child will be selected for the program. An interview is required and your application is **NOT** complete until you have conducted the interview. This program is not a first come first served program, it is based on eligibility.
