First Day of School

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Birthday Celebrations

Parents will NOT be allowed to bring items to the cafeteria to celebrate birthdays. However, we want your child to feel special on his/her birthday. Parents may drop off **store bought** cupcakes or cookies to the front office in the morning with your child's name and teacher name on the package (no goodie bags are allowed). The teacher will distribute the birthday cupcakes or cookies during the last hour of the day.

Safety and Security

In the aftermath of the tragedy that occurred at Marjory Stoneman Douglas as well as other schools across the nation and implementation of the Marjory Stoneman Douglas state law High School Public Safety Act (SB7026). Nob Hill Elementary has continued to make safety a top priority by enhancing security measures for our students and staff.

Arrival

All gates will open at 7:15 am. Parents may park at the soccer lot and walk their child to school. Parents should not park on the swale in front of the school to avoid getting a ticket from the Sunrise Police Department. Parents should only cross at the crossing guard to ensure safety when crossing the street.

Pre-K and IND Special Class Parents

Students will be dropped off in the south loop. Designated staff will meet the students on the sidewalk and escort the students to the cafeteria using the 4th grade hallway.

K and 1st Grade Parents

Students will be dropped off in the front office loop and will exit the car to the sidewalk and enter the building through the double doors next to the front office. All parents will receive a tag to place in the front of your car window. Students will enter the double doors next to the front office.

2nd – 5th Grade Parents

Students will be dropped off in the south loop near the cafeteria. You must drive all the way down to the last cone. Your child will exit the car to the sidewalk and enter the front double doors next to the front office.

Dismissal

No students will be picked up for early dismissal after 1:30.

Bike Riders: Students will be walked to the bicycle gate and they will cross at the crossing guard.

Walkers: Students will be walked to the crossing guard.

Car Riders: K students will be picked up from the K playground. 1st grade will be dismissed from the front loop. 2-5 grade will be dismissed from the south loop by the cafeteria.

KidCare: Students will be walked by their KidCare Counselors to the cafeteria.

Private Day Care Providers: Students will be escorted to their bus in the front loop by the office.



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Safety and Security

Perimeter Gates

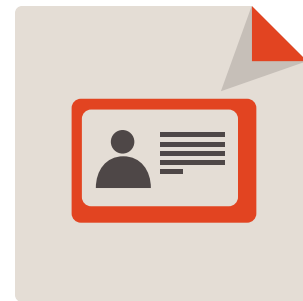
All perimeter gates will be locked at 8:30am every day. This includes the main gate at the front of the school. The gate will remain locked and visitors to the campus must call the school's office at (754)322-7227 to gain entry to the campus. Each visitor must show the school staff official photo identification. Visitors will be asked the purpose of their visit at the school for the day.

Security Tracking and Response (STAR) System

Upon entry to campus, all visitors must be processed through the STAR System. This includes all parents, District staff, vendors, volunteers, and members of the public. Each visitor must present an official photo identification. Each visitor will also be requested to sign in and out on the visitor's log.

Emergency Drills

Emergency preparedness and response drills/training will continue this school year on a regular basis. This includes fire drills, tornado drills and critical incident drills. NHE will conduct two Fire Drills, a Tornado Drill and a Code Red Drill within the first two weeks of school. A Code Red Drill will be conducted each month.



Student and Staff Identification Badges

All staff and students will wear identification badges during the school day. Additionally, individuals visiting NHE must wear identification badges while on campus.

KidCare Supervision

A Campus Monitor has been hired to ensure safety continues during the extended day. All parents will enter the front door using the single point of entry. Emergency preparedness and response drills/training will continue on a regular basis for fire, tornado and critical incident drills.
