Additional Important Information

The first day of school is Monday, August 12. Please know that we permit parents of Pre-K and Kindergarten students to walk their child to class on the first day only. If you are a parent of a Pre-K or Kindergarten student and will be walking your child to class, we ask that you exit our campus by 8:00 am so that we can secure our facility and begin our first day!
