Legislative Report: Interim Committee Week 2

OVERVIEW

The Legislature held its second Interim Committee Week, October 11-15, 2021. The Appropriations and Education Committees observed presentations on education topics and previously passed legislation. Amy Baker, Coordinator, Office of Economics and Demographic Research presented the Long-Range Financial Outlook to the Senate Appropriations Committee. Based on the presentation, Florida's economy is likely to slow as Federal Stimulus Dollars desiccate; however, in the near term, the Legislature will have an additional \$2.6 Billion when crafting the state's budget along with billions of used Federal stimulus dollars.
