One of the big issues is finding chairs and how long they can serve. Two distinct groups in the district: (1) Parent driven and (2) organizations like TAC.

2. Business before the Committee

a. IT Division Comprehensive Update – Board Workshop (Phil Dunn)

- How does IT support teaching and learning?
 - Creating outcomes for students in the classroom
 - Three-legged stool: OSPA (Instruction -Teachers and Principals), OoA (Curriculum), and IT (Resources)
 - IT role - Supporting teachers and students and creating great learning outcomes.
- Behind the Scenes: Network Operations (Security, Cyber, Internet), Payroll Processing, Hardware Maintenance (Laptops and Cameras), System Administration, Solution Design, State Reporting (FTE and Grants)
- IT vision includes: Personalized Learning at Scale, High Speed Internet, 1:1 Computer Issuance, Continuity of Business Operations, and Safe Schools
- Over the last 3 years we have pulled out almost 20% of general funds from IT and the “service footprint” has more than tripled.
- 5 Big Challenges: Student Information System (SIS) Upgrade, ERP (SAP) Migration and Upgrade, Digital Learning, Cybersecurity, Modernization
- Human side of change: Talent Optimization (upskill staff with rapidly changing technology), Change Management (organization able to change and adapt to new technologies and processes), and Succession (building succession plans)

b. Nominations Committee/Annual Election of Officers – SY 20-21(Dale Bondanza/Beth Anne Carr)

- We will finish out with our current officers and they will continue until SY 21-22 until such time as we have a quorum to establish a nominations committee and an election.
- If we have a quorum in May, we might be able to nominate a slate of officers for next year.
