3. Business before the Committee

- a. TAC Policy/Bylaws revision Continued discussion on appointed members how to get a practical number of participants. The policy/bylaws committee has been working on updating the policy to align with other policies and bylaws. Looking at policy that establishes committees and another that dictates rules for meetings. We used the District Advisory Committee to see what they have done to adjust their bylaws and policies. Spoke with Dr. Leo Nesmith to get his input and feedback to help guide this discussion.
 - i. Additional participants were included: Safety and Security, Micro Techs, Magnet/Charter Schools, Nova Public Library, Finance Division
 - ii. Possible majority quorum required numbers: If 37 appointed members need 19 for the quorum, for 31 appointed members need 16 for the quorum
 - iii. To pass new bylaws and policies requires three meetings with the Board a 4 to 5-month process.
 - 1. Workshop to represent the new policies and bylaws
 - 2. The second workshop has to be advertised as a public meeting and a formal adoption by the Board.
 - 3. The third time we go to an official Board meeting with a CC item (Board policy item)
