Employment Criteria:

- EDUCATION:** Must possess basic comprehension and fluency in English. Standard high school diploma or satisfactory completion of an approved General Equivalency Diploma (GED) Testing Program preferred.
- EXPERIENCE:** Working or volunteering in an atmosphere which included mentally, physically and/or emotionally special needs children or adults is preferred.
- ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:** Must be at least eighteen (18) years of age. Possess sensitivity to the needs and feelings of individuals requiring special care. Ability to control student behavior to the extent necessary for the driver to safely perform the driving assignment required.
- HIRING REQUIREMENTS:** Prior to riding with students on a school bus each bus attendant shall meet the following requirements:
 - a) Successfully complete forty (40) hours of pre-service training consisting based on Broward County School Board Bus Attendant curriculum or equivalent training as determined by Director or designee.
 - b) Demonstrate the physical and mental capabilities required to carry out all assigned responsibilities as a bus attendant. Demonstrate the ability to prepare required written reports.
