Subject: Certificate of Occupancy Information/Growth Trends

The School Board of Broward County, Florida (SBBC) requests your assistance in forecasting five-year residential development trends in Broward County. This report is being prepared, in part, to satisfy the requirements of Section 4.4 of the Third Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement for Public School Facility Planning, Broward County, Florida. In accordance with Section 4.4, the County and Municipalities are required to provide the Superintendent of Schools with an annual report on growth and development trends within their jurisdiction. This information is utilized to forecast student enrollments for all Broward County Schools.

Two attachments are provided for your assistance: a blank planned development spreadsheet for your planning agency to complete and a Traffic Analysis Zone map to be used as a reference to identify residential development locations. To complete the blank spreadsheet, simply insert the number of units anticipated to receive certificates of occupancy (COs) in your community for single family, townhouse (duplex), garden apartment, mid-rise (4 to 8 stories), high-rise (9 or more stories) and mobile home building types (including the number of bedrooms) for calendar years 2021 through 2026. Also, please provide the SBBC project number associated with the development.

Please submit your completed spreadsheet to Joseph Beck (joseph.beck@browardschools.com), Demographics & Enrollment Planning Department at Broward County Public Schools, by August 31, 2021. After the August 31, 2021 compliance deadline, city managers with delinquent CO reports will be contacted to provide their planning agency's delinquent annual CO report.
