SUBJECT: **PRELIMINARY 2009-10 TWENTIETH DAY ENROLLMENT REPORT**

This memorandum provides the official preliminary school District enrollment to be used for statistical purposes. Total preliminary enrollment membership for this year on the twentieth day is 255,203 representing pre-kindergarten (PreK) through grade 12 students enrolled in all public schools, centers, and charter schools. The final Twentieth Day Enrollment Report, to be distributed on September 23, 2009, will include individual school enrollment data disaggregated by ethnicity, English Language Learners (ELL), Exceptional Student Education (ESE), Free or Reduced Lunch (FRL) and the ten year enrollment trend.

The Districtwide enrollment decreased **this year by 535 students compared to the 2008-09 twentieth day enrollment**. Table 1 shows the historical twentieth day enrollment count decrease over the past five years.
