September 7, 2017	The Procurement & Warehousing Services (PWS) Department performed an initial assessment and identified 79 current bids used by the Physical Plant Operations (PPO) Department. PWS manages all the current bids for the District organized by commodities; the research mentioned above only includes goods/services under the following commodities: Grounds; Structure (exterior); Facilities; Maintenance, and Repair (interior). From the 79 contracts, 28 had pricing established on labor based on an hourly rate. Please note, this does not necessarily mean that these bids demonstrate excessive pricing, rather that we are in the process of researching the details of these 28 contracts to better understand the need and the usage of such hourly rates. This analysis is a work in progress with the collaboration of both PPO and Accounts Payable to help conclude and or determine any risk associated with pricing that has been received in relation to any of these goods and services bids mentioned above.
