EXECUTIVE SUMMARY Recommendation to Approve 2022-23 Capital Fund Amendment #4 As of March 31, 2023

Requested Action

Approve Capital Fund Amendment #4 and appropriate \$2,454,574, to fund the Deaf and Hardof-Hearing (DHH) audio visual project and \$500,000, to fund the site clean-up at Peters Elementary School. District 5 and District 6

Impact if the Board Voted Yes or No

If the Board votes "Yes" - Staff would:

- Implement Phase 2 of the DHH Audio Visual Enhancement Project that will increase safety for DHH students and staff at four schools with a higher DHH population.
- Initiate remediation of identified soil contamination at Peters Elementary.

If the Board Votes "No" - There would be no funding to:

- Implement Phase 2 of the DHH Audio Visual Enhancement Project and the students and staff risk missing fire alarms or other emergency alerts.
- Excavate contaminated soil at Peters Elementary, which could result in Broward County issuing the District a Warning Notice and fine.

Background/History

DHH Project

Phase 2 of the DHH Audio Visual Enhancement project will enhance emergency notifications and communications for the DHH Community. The project will include a new all-in-one digital notification, audio notification, in-classroom audio enhancement, and intercom system. The full functionality of the system will be utilized at Peters Elementary School, Tropical Elementary School, and Seminole Middle School. However, since South Plantation High School already has a new intercom system, the intercom functionality of this system is not expected to be activated at this site.

- Phase 2 of this project includes additional devices being purchased and installed in common areas and critical notification areas at each of these schools.
- Note Phase 1 of the project is already completed, involving installation of Alertus software on District computers and programming a local Rapid Response Console in each school's administrative area.

Soil Remediation Project

Soil contamination was identified at Peters Elementary, and the District obtained an Environmental Assessment and Remediation License with Broward County in 2019 per Section 27-358(d)(1) Broward County Code. Soil assessment activities were completed with the submittal of a Limited Contamination Assessment Report (Third Addendum) in April 2022. The follow-up Remedial Action Plan (RAP)was submitted to Broward County Environmental Protection & Growth Management Department (EPGMD) in January 2023 documenting the plans for source removal and conditional closure of the Site. A proposal was requested from and submitted by the

Miscellaneous Environmental Services vendor (Bid FY22-121) for \$492,623.75. A total request of \$500,000 will cover this activity with a small contingency.

Alignment to 2027 Goals and Guardrails

Guardrail 1: Safety - These projects can avoid an unsafe circumstance for students and staff.

Guardrail 5: Accountability - This is presented to the School Board to comply with statutory requirements per Fla. Admin. Code R. 6A-1.007.

Measurable Outcome(s)/Return on Investment

At these schools with a higher percentage of DHH students and staff, the physical and financial risks of a missed fire alarm or other emergency alert are greater. By adding visual displays in these schools, everyone at the campuses is better able to respond to emergency alerts.

The contaminated soil excavation is required to comply with Broward County and State environmental regulations and to obtain closure of the site as it relates to the identified petroleum discharge.

Financial Impact

- Total Financial Impact of this item is \$2,954,574
- This amendment requests appropriating \$2,454,574 and \$500,000 from the capital unallocated reserve for the two respective scopes of work (DHH and soil remediation).
- Spend Authority for the devices and equipment was included as part of the bid approval for "Audio Visual Products, Service & Computer Peripherals (Catalog)" during the December 13, 2022, Board meeting (OO-17 ITB-FY23-016).
