SUBJECT: **REDUCING MOSQUITO EXPOSURE AT DISTRICT SITES FOR THE 2019 RAINY SEASON**

Please implement the following mosquito control measures at your site in preparation of our students and staffs return for the new school year.

- ✓ Remove any containers inside and outside of all buildings that may hold water and contribute to mosquito breeding.
 - Water retention areas designed for water percolation back into the regions ground supply are exempt.
 - Common standing water sources on school or ancillary sites may include:
 - Buckets
 - Trash cans
 - Planters
 - Tires
 - Playground equipment needing repair
 - Spaces beneath portables
 - Flower vases and planters
 - Clogged Gutters
 - Flat roof areas where puddling occurs
 - Birdbaths
- ✓ Monitor your site on a regular basis to identify mosquito breeding conditions and eliminate them. If your site is experiencing on-going mosquito problems, Broward County Schools and Administrative Sites may **only** request Broward County mosquito spray service by filling out and submitting the form by clicking the following link:
