

Thank you to all who participated in the 2019-22 Strategic Plan Committee kickoff meeting this month! The session was extremely well attended by **over 70** staff members, administrators, school principals, teachers, partnering organizations, and community members from across our District.

We received welcome remarks from **Mr. Maurice Woods**, Chief Strategy & Operations Officer, followed by a presentation by **Dr. Deborah Posner**, Executive Director of Strategic Initiative Management (SIM). She shared an overview of the District's current Strategic Plan, as well as the SIM framework and tools for **strategic planning**, **execution**, and **project management**.
