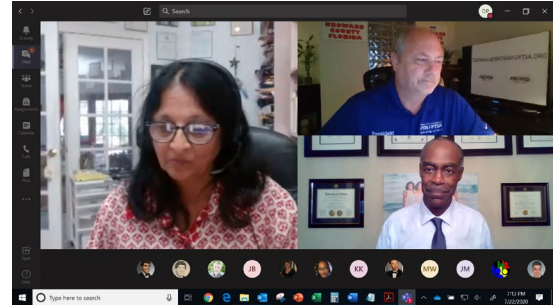

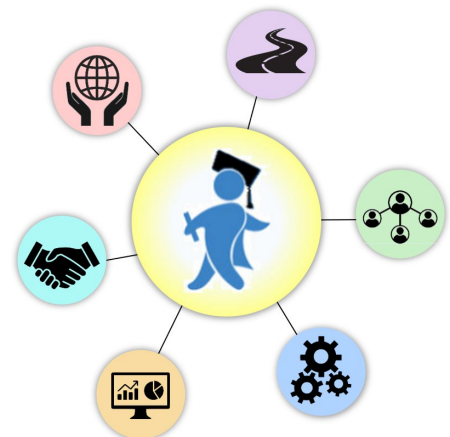
Our school reopening plans continue to evolve on a weekly basis, and the regular input of all of our stakeholders is key to ensuring we best meet the needs of our students and our community.
