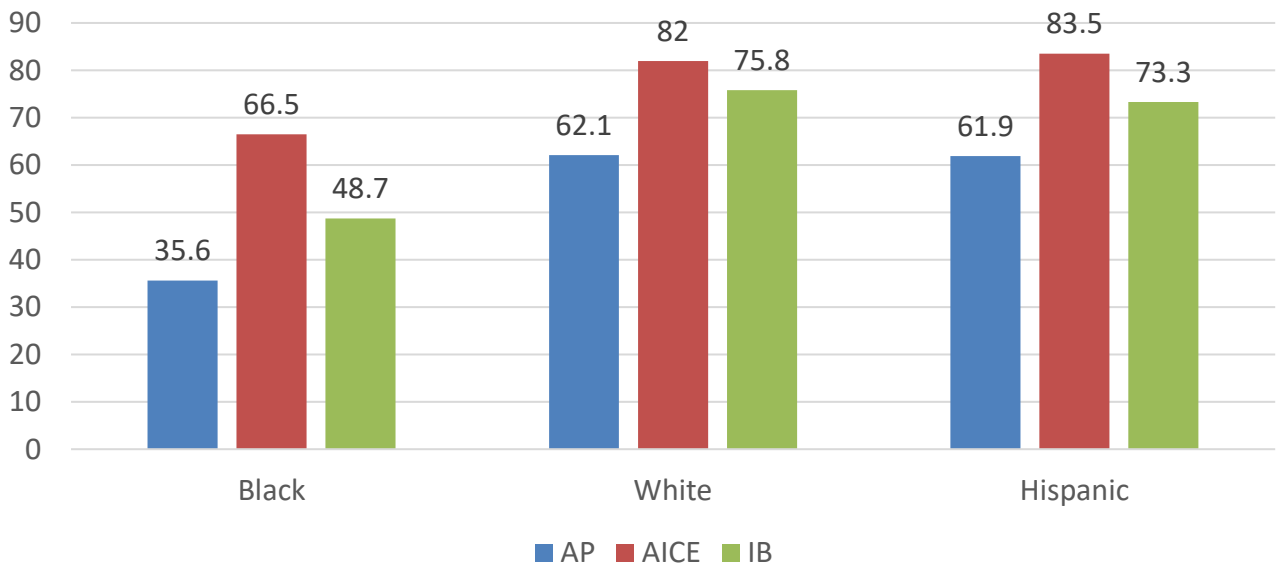

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AP, AICE, and IB At-A-Glance

- In school year, 2021-2022 13,888 students completed 24,271 AP exams (1.7 tests per student), 10,796 students completed 23,449 AICE exams (2.2 tests per student) and 228 students completed 655 IB exams (2.9 tests per student).
- Asian students outperformed their peers on AP and IB exams, and Native American peers scored higher on average than their peers on AICE exams.
- Comparing passing rates of the three largest racial/ethnic groups, Hispanics outperformed their peers on AICE exams, and White student outperformed their peers on AP and IB exams.
- Further, the gap in passing rates was largest between White and Black students on the IB exams (27.1) and smallest between White and Hispanic Students (-1.5) on AICE exams.

RATIONALE: This memo, the snapshot and the attached appendices summarize student participation and scores from the Advanced Placement Program (AP), Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) and the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme offered during school year 2022. The AP program provides an opportunity for high school students to experience college-level coursework and demonstrate mastery of content on national, subject-specific examinations. AP exams are scored on a scale of 1 to 5, and many colleges and universities will award course credit for scores of 3 or higher.¹

The Cambridge AICE Diploma is an international curriculum and examination system that emphasizes the value of broad and balanced study. Alongside in-depth understanding of a variety of subjects, students also need to master a broader range of skills critical for success in university study and employment. AICE exams are scored on an eight-point scale, and many colleges and universities will award course credit for scores of 3 or higher.²

The IB Diploma Programme is an international curriculum and examination system that aims to provide a challenging and comprehensive education that enables students to understand and manage the complexities of their world and provide them with skills and attitudes for taking responsible action for the future. The IB curriculum offers a curriculum that prioritizes skills in writing, critical thinking, creativity, and service to communities. Students are taught via a teaching model that emphasizes inquiry, reflection, and action. Courses culminate in an exam that is graded on a seven-point scale and some colleges and universities will award course credit for scores of 4 or higher.³

Advanced Placement Program

Student participation rates, overall and by race/ethnicity

As shown in Table 1, 21% of Broward high school students participated in the AP program and completed 24,271 exams in school year 2021-2022. Twelfth grade students took more AP courses on average than other grade levels.

AP participants completed, on average, 1.7 AP exams in 2021-2022. Asian students took more tests on average when compared to their peers of other race/ethnicities. When looking at participation rates of the three largest racial/ethnic groups in Broward County, there was little difference in the number of tests taken on average.

Scores and passing rates by race/ethnicity

In school year 2022, student participants passed AP exams at a rate of 57.5%. Table 3 shows the passing rates by race and ethnic group for school year 2022. Hispanic student participants completed the highest number of AP exams when compared to their peers of other races. Asian participants (70%) passed AP exams at a higher rate when compared to students of other races and ethnicity followed by White students (62.1%). Furthermore, when looking at passing rates of the three largest racial/ethnic groups in Broward

ADVANCED INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION (AICE)

Student participation rates, overall and by race/ethnicity

As shown in Table 4, 16.3% of Broward high school students participated in the AICE program and completed 23,449 exams in school year 2021-2022. Tenth grade students took more courses on average than other grade levels.

AICE participants completed, on average, 2.0 AICE exams in 2021-2022. Hispanic participants completed more exams (8,459) than students of other races. There was little variability between races when looking at the average number of exams completed (0.1).

Scores and passing rates by Race

In school year 2022, student participants passed AICE exams at a rate of 79.2%. Table 6 shows the passing rates by race and ethnic group for school year 2022. Native American participants (88.7%) passed AICE exams at a higher rate when compared to students of other races and ethnicity followed closely by Asian students (87.1%) and Hispanic students (83.5%). Furthermore, when looking at passing rates of the three largest racial/ethnic groups in Broward County, Hispanic student participants outperformed White and Black students by 1.5% and 17% respectively.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

Student participation rates, overall and by race/ethnicity

As shown in Table 7, 2.0% of Broward high school students participated in the IB program and completed 655 exams in school year 2021-2022. Twelfth grade students completed more courses on average than other grade levels.

IB participants completed, on average, 2.9 IB exams in 2021-2022. When looking at participation rates of the three largest racial/ethnic groups in Broward County, Black student participants (3.0) took more IB exams than White and Hispanic students by 0.2 and 0.4 respectively.

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Scores and passing rates by Race

In school year 2022, student participants passed IB exams at a rate of 64.3%. Table 9 shows the passing rates by race and ethnic group for school year 2022. Black student participants (136) passed the highest number of IB exams when compared to their peers of other races. Asian participants (81.4%) passed IB exams at a higher rate when compared to students of other races and ethnicity followed by White students (75.8%). Furthermore, when looking at passing rates of the three largest racial/ethnic groups in Broward County, White student participants outperformed Hispanic and Black students by 2.5% and 27.1% respectively.
