





- Attendance was lower for high schools (87.8%) compared to elementary (92.1%), middle (92.9%), and multi-level schools (93.3%). Attendance at centers was the lowest (63.0%).
- White students had a higher daily attendance rate (91.4%) than Hispanic and Black students (90.9% and 90.1%). Also, Black students had a higher proportion of unexcused absences (71.8%) than Hispanic (61.0%) or White students (47.8%).
- Average absence per student ranged from 12 at multi-level schools to 51 at centers during the 2021-22 school year.
- A higher proportion of absences were unexcused (62.7%) than excused (36.8%) during the 2021-22. This increase is seen at all school levels and all student subgroups.
- Multi-level schools had the smallest proportion of students categorized as having either chronic or severe chronic absenteeism (23.2%), followed by middle (24.1%), elementary (29.5%), high (43.9%), and centers (78.0%).


### Attendance Rate by School Level

### SUBJECT: STUDENT ATTENDANCE IN BROWARD COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS 2021-22

The 2021-22 school year was the first full school year all students returned to school since the Coronavirus pandemic. This brief summarizes attendance in Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) for the 2021-22 school year at both District and Charter schools.

Broward County Public Schools' overall average daily attendance rate (ADA) for 2021-22 was 90.8%. In 2021-22, the ADA rate was similar for elementary and middle schools (92.1% and 92.9%) yet was higher for multi-level schools (93.3%). High schools and Centers recorded the lowest ADA rate (87.8% and 63.0%).

During the 2021-22 school year, ADA rates for the three largest racial/ethnic groups varied. Black students had the lowest ADA rate (90.1%), followed by Hispanic students (90.9%) and White students (91.4%). The same pattern existed when looking at the type of absence by race/ethnicity. Black students registered the largest percentage of unexcused absences (71.8%), followed by Hispanic students (61.0%) and White students (47.8%).

Broward data for the 2021-22 school year were examined using the attendance categories that align with the School Improvement Plans. The categories are: Regular Attenders (0 – 4.9% absences), At-Risk (5 – 9.9% absences), Chronic Absence (10 – 19.9% absences), and Severe Chronic Absenteeism (20% or more absences). For students categorized as having either chronic or severe chronic absenteeism, multi-level had the smallest proportion of students (23.2%), followed by middle schools (24.1%), elementary (29.5%), high (43.9%), and centers (78.0%).

## STUDENT ATTENDANCE IN BROWARD COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS 2021-22

The 2021-22 school year was the first full school year students returned to school since the Coronavirus Pandemic. This brief summarizes attendance in Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) for the 2021-22 school year at both District and charter schools.

### METHOD

Data, excluding summers, were gathered from the District's data warehouse. The total population reflects the number of students in grades kindergarten through 12 who attended a BCPS school for at least five days during the year. Student absences are credited to the school the student attended the most during the school year. Absences are classified as excused (parent/guardian notified the school), unexcused (no parent/guardian notified the school), or suspension (external suspension). Results are presented in figures and tables, and additional materials are included in appendices.

### OVERALL ATTENDANCE





Figure 1. Average daily attendance rate, by school level, 2021-22.

The overall District average daily attendance (ADA) rate was 90.8% in 2021-22. Figure 1 illustrates the ADA rate by school level also see Appendix A.

Figure 2 shows the average number of days absent per student by school level for 2021-22. Historically, high school students averaged more days absent than middle,

elementary, and multi-level students. Students at centers averaged just under five times as many days absent than students at the high school level (also see Appendix B).

Table 1 displays the average daily attendance rate by race/ethnicity for 2021-22. Looking at the three largest race/ethnicities, Black students had the lowest average daily attendance rate (90.1), followed by Hispanic students (90.9), and White students (91.4) in the 2021-22 school year.


Table 2 displays the number and percent of students with perfect attendance and students with fifteen or more total absences, by school level. Multi-level schools had the highest percent of students with perfect attendance (9.8%), followed by center (8.1%) and middle schools (3.9%). Elementary and high schools had the lowest percent of students with perfect attendance (2.9%, and 2.6%, respectively). Centers had the highest percent of students with fifteen or more absences (75.3%). High schools had the next highest (48.7%), followed by elementary (34.3%), middle (28.6%), and multi-level schools (28.0%).

#### **ABSENCES BY TYPE: EXCUSED, UNEXCUSED, AND SUSPENSION**

Figure 3 shows the percent of absences disaggregated by type: excused, unexcused, and suspension, by school level for 2021-22. Centers had the highest percent of unexcused absences (90.1%), followed by high schools (66.2%). The school level with the lowest percent of unexcused absences was middle schools (51.7%; also see Appendix D).





Figure 4. Rate of absence by type and by largest racial/ethnic groups, 2021-22.

Figure 4 shows the percent of excused, unexcused, and suspension data based on the total number of absences, by the largest student racial/ethnic groups. The data show that Black students registered a higher unexcused absence percent (71.8%) than Hispanic (61.0%) or White students (47.8%; also see Appendix E).

### ATTENDANCE CATEGORIES IN 2021-22

Passed by Congress in 2015, the federal education law, Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), replaces No Child Left Behind (U.S. Department of Education, 2017). States must include five indicators of school quality, four on academic achievement, and a fifth, non-academic measure. Many states chose chronic absenteeism as the fifth indicator (Jordan & Miller, 2017). Florida's ESSA plan requires school districts to implement an early warning system which identifies students in K-8 who may need additional support to succeed in school. As part of the early warning system, attendance must be included (Florida Department of Education, 2018).

Broward data for the 2021-22 school year were examined using the attendance categories that align with the School Improvement Plans. The categories are: Regular Attenders (0 – 4.9% absences); At-Risk (5 – 9.9% absences); Chronic Absenteeism (10 – 19.9% absences); and Severe Chronic Absenteeism (20% or more absences). Multi-level schools had the smallest proportion of students categorized as having either chronic or severe chronic absenteeism (23.2%), followed by Middle (24.1%), elementary (29.5%), high (43.9%), and centers (78.0%); (see Figure 6 and Appendix G).

## SCHOOL LEVEL ATTENDANCE INFORMATION IN 2021-22

Detailed attendance information at the school level, including absence by type, students with 10 or more unexcused absences, students with 15 or more total absences, the average daily attendance rate, and the average number of absences per student, are available in Appendix G.

### SUMMARY

#### Overall Trends in Attendance

- Attendance was lower for high schools (87.8%) compared to elementary (92.1%), middle (92.9%), and multi-level schools (93.3%). Attendance at centers was the lowest (63.0%) (see Figure 1 and Appendix A).
- Students enrolled at centers missed an average of 51 days during the 2021-22 school year. On average, high school students missed 21 days, elementary school and multi-level school students missed 13 and 12 days, and middle school students missed 12 days during the same time period (see Figure 2 and Appendix B).
- White students had the highest average daily attendance rate (91.4%), followed by Hispanic students (90.9%), and Black students (90.1%) in the 2021-22 school year (see Table 1 and Appendix C).

#### Attendance Type in 2021-22

- Perfect attendance:* Multi-level schools had the highest percentage of students with perfect attendance (9.8%), followed by centers (8.1%), middle schools (3.9%), and elementary schools (2.9%). High schools had the lowest percentage of students with perfect attendance (2.6%; see Table 2).
- Fifteen or more absences:* Centers had the highest percentage of students with 15 or more absences (75.3%). High schools had the next highest (48.7%), followed by elementary schools (34.3%), middle schools (28.6%), and multi-level (28.0%; see Table 2).
- Unexcused absences by school level:* Centers had the highest percent of unexcused absences (90.1%), followed by high schools (66.2%). The lowest percent of unexcused absences was in middle schools (51.7%; see Figure 3 and Appendix D).
- Unexcused absences by race/ethnicity:* Black students had a higher percent of unexcused absences (71.8%), compared to Hispanic students (61.0%), and White students (47.8%; see Figure 4 and Appendix E).

#### Attendance Categories in 2021-22

- Multi-level schools had the smallest proportion of students categorized as having either chronic or severe chronic absenteeism (23.2%), followed by middle (24.1%), elementary (29.5%), high (43.9%), and centers (78.0%; see Figure 6 and Appendix G).

## DISCUSSION

The District Attendance Office, responsible for developing Tier 1 interventions and goals for all schools, analyzing, and sharing comprehensive attendance data, and developing policy change, has taken the following actions to address attendance in the past year:

### **Mandatory Training and Attendance Record Keeping**

The BCPS Attendance Office developed three role-specific training courses for teachers, principals, and attendance clerks on monitoring student attendance. The courses were coordinated with the Professional Development Standards & Support Department and delivered on the Canvas learning platform. Training included a review of Florida laws and District policy, guidelines for attendance record keeping, the role of each group in the process, and best practices for improving regular attendance.

Regular communication was shared during the school year with administrators, staff, and a variety of stakeholders, regarding the importance of accurate attendance record keeping. This included updates to attendance codes and ensuring that an attendance code was entered for each student every school day. Principals received quarterly reports and end-of-semester analyses to aid in the understanding of the shifts in student attendance data and how it impacts student achievement.

The Coordinator for District Attendance was available as a resource for school-based staff, school leaders, and parents that needed assistance with aligning practice to policy or had student-specific questions.

### **Attendance Awareness Activities 2021-22**

In the Summer of 2021, The District embarked upon the “Student Reengagement Initiative” to support our most vulnerable families in alleviating their barriers to attendance for SY21-22. Using end-of-the-year data from SY20-21, District staff sought out to identify and reengage students who had not returned to school post Coronavirus Pandemic and remote learning. Senior leaders partnered with an outside company to develop an electronic system to capture the telephone calls, home visits and overall outreach to families. Outcomes of these efforts included students registering back in school, and accurately coding students who moved out of the area or transferred to an alternative educational setting.

Schools were outfitted with Tier 1 Universal supports like fence banners and hallway banners to be displayed in each school. Each banner has a QR code to assist parents with reporting absences online to streamline and increase the timely reporting of student absences. Schools received printed promotional materials to be distributed and other marketing items that encourage improved attendance and community engagement. The Attendance Coordinator began the practice of visiting schools with student unexcused absence rates of 55% or higher in the Spring of 2022. The visits were to ensure that Information Management Technicians and Attendance Managers were being trained,

using the training materials as daily resources and that the schools had Tier 1 Universal Supports on display.

During the 2021-22 school year, the Miami Marlins continued partnerships with the BCPS Attendance Office. Students with stellar attendance continued to be recognized and offered incentives with support to help improve student attendance. Parents were notified through the ParentLink system by voice messages, email, and text messages. Through the Good Student Program, the Miami Marlins organization provided approximately 150,000 eligible students in Broward County Public Schools with free game tickets, which included family packs and discounts for additional tickets.

Broward County Public Schools celebrated "Evening with the Stars" on May 3, 2022, at Plantation High School. Five students were acknowledged as "Best in Class" and honored by Congressman Ted Deutch on the House floor in Washington D.C, where their names were added to the Congressional record. The students were also recognized by NBC 6 News for their perfect attendance record. In the wake of Coronavirus Pandemic, our students maintained perfect attendance, which was a significant achievement. Each student gave a tour of their school and participated in interviews with reporter Ari Odzer, detailing how they were able to persevere throughout the pandemic. Additionally, the "Best in Class" students were individually recognized by the Miami Dolphins, Miami Heat, and the Miami Marlins, for their achievements.

### **School Improvement Plan (SIP) Attendance Plan**

The SIP Attendance Plan for SY2021-22 was developed post Coronavirus Pandemic to include accommodations that were necessary due to the continued impact on attendance. A new attendance code, "Q", was created to support students who needed to quarantine but were still able to remain academically engaged. Goals were pre-identified and written for each school by the District Attendance Office. School Leadership teams were expected to regularly monitor and review the percentage of Regular Attenders, At-Risk, Moderately Chronic, and Severely Chronic students. The District Attendance Office provided consultation to the school teams as it relates to the data in the groups to support the specific needs of students and parents. Each school's administrative team determined the next steps for each student with guidance from one or more support teams, such as the school-based Response to Intervention Team (RtI) and the district-based Multi-tiered System of Support team (MTSS).

The SIP Attendance Plan for SY22-23 included a detailed template for schools to complete along with a list of tiered interventions based on a functional "Whole School" Supports model. An interactive attendance dashboard and templates were made available in the Mandatory Attendance Course. At each tier, attendance strategies and interventions provided recommendations to address the following areas: Monitored Data, Engaged Students and Families, Recognized Good and Improved Attendance, Provided Personalized Outreach, and Removed Barriers.

## **District Attendance Committee**

The District Attendance Committee improved knowledge of how chronic absences and tardies impact student attendance and achievement. The Committee continues to prove how parental/ community engagement via an active group of internal and external stakeholders can bring forth positive change throughout the District. The District Attendance Committee continues to monitor trends in student attendance data, and results of School Improvement Plans, and celebrate student success. The group continuously seeks ways to improve communication regarding attendance trends and their impact.
