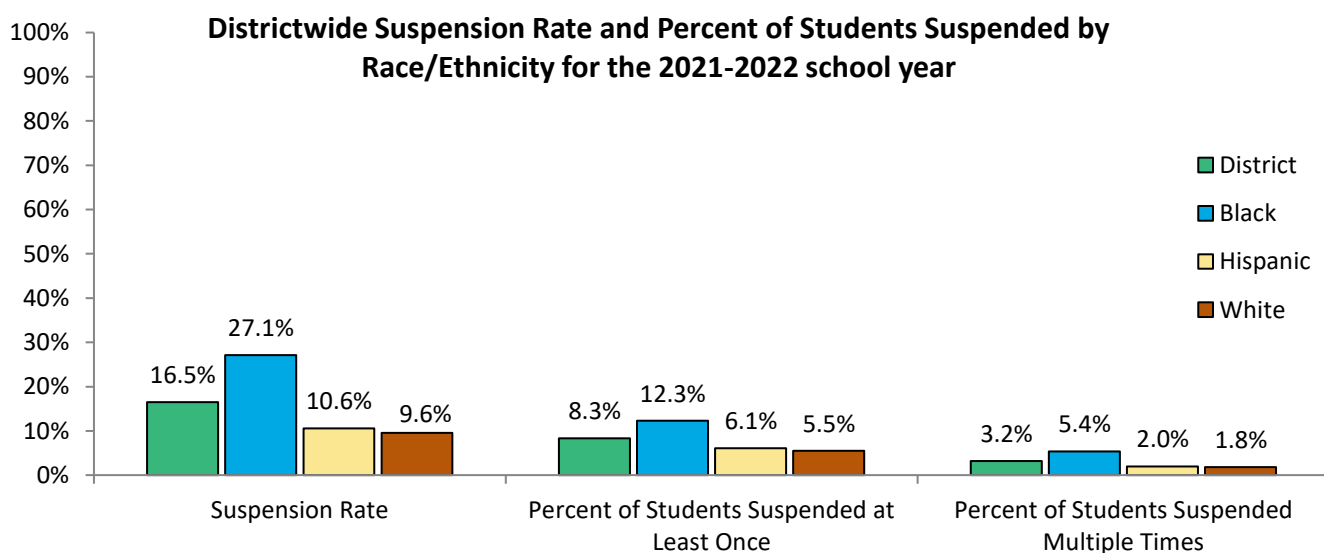
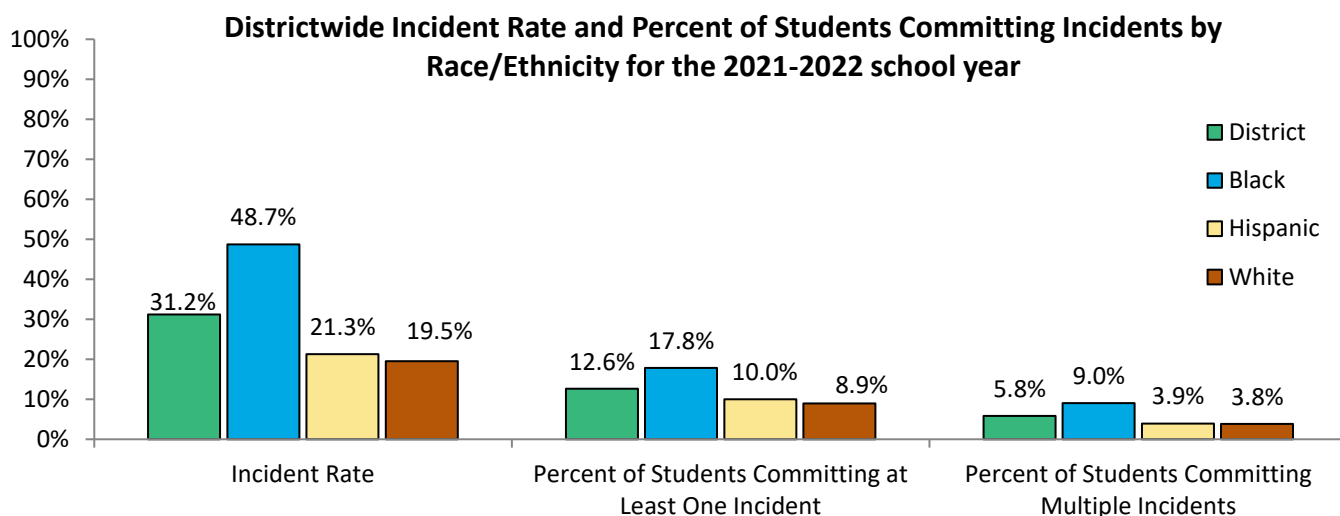


During the 2021-2022 School year the Incident Rate was

- The Incident Rate was 31.2% for the 2021-2022 school year. The percent of students committing at least one incident was 12.6% in the same time period, with the percent of students committing multiple incidents at less than 5.8%.
- The Suspension Rate was 16.5% in the 2021-2022 school year. The percent of students suspended at least once in the same time period was 8.3%. The percent of students suspended multiple times was less than 3.2%.
- Black students registered the highest incident and suspension rate compared to that of Hispanic and White students.

ACTION: Principals should continue to monitor findings in order to continuously improve processes and procedures.

RATIONALE: The incident rate during the 2021-2022 was 31.2%, and the percent of students committing at least one incident was 12.6%. During the same time period the suspension rate was 16.5% with 8.3% of students receiving at least one type of suspension.

Black students registered the greatest incident rate at 48.7%, with 17.8% committing at least one incident. White students registered an incident rate of 19.5%, with 8.9% committing at least one incident. The incident rate for Hispanic students was also 21.3%, with 10.0% committing at least one incident.

This report presents Districtwide incident and suspension data overall and by race and school level. Incidents are further broken out into categories that appear on the discipline matrix in order to provide information to support schools in selecting interventions and creating positive behavior plans.

BEHAVIOR INCIDENTS AND SUSPENSIONS IN BROWARD COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS, 2021-2022

The District's Code of Student Conduct Handbook 2021-2024 (School Board Policy 5.8A) provides policies, rules, and laws designed to create a positive school culture and safe environment that is conducive to learning. Behavioral incidents occur when a student's actions are not in accordance with the Code of Student Conduct Handbook 2021-2024. The majority of disciplinary issues are expected to be addressed by teachers. If the issue is not resolved at the classroom level, it then gets referred to the school's Collaborative Problem-Solving Team for a multi-tiered intervention to be developed and monitored (School Board of Broward County, 2022a).

Some incidents are more severe and warrant mandatory disciplinary action. Consequences to incidents are intended to match the severity of the misbehavior. Major violations and repeat offenses are met with stronger consequences. In all circumstances, exclusion from school is reserved for situations in which all other disciplinary means have been exhausted.

The District's Code of Student Conduct Handbook 2021-2024 contains a discipline matrix which offers guidelines for assigning consequences to violations of school board policies. Since 2013-2014, policy 5006 afforded principals more flexibility, offering the matrix as a guideline for assigning consequences, but allowing principals to use their own discretion to accommodate any mitigating or aggravating circumstances (School Board of Broward County, 2022b).

This report examines the past year of student behavioral incident and suspension data in Broward County Public Schools (BCPS). The 2021-2022 school year was the first full school year students returned to school since the Coronavirus pandemic. Only 2021-2022 incident and suspension data are provided in this report as prior years data are not comparable due to the Coronavirus pandemic.

I. METHOD

Incident and suspension data for both traditional and charter schools were retrieved from the District's data warehouse for the past school year (2021-2022). Data are presented overall as well as by school level (elementary, middle, high, and center) and by race/ethnicity. Incidents are further broken out into categories that appear on the discipline matrix (attendance, rules violation, disruptive, substance abuse/drugs, acts against persons, property, bus, and other criminal). Suspensions are further classified

into three categories: internal suspension, external suspension, and alternative to external suspension (AES).

II. DEFINITIONS AND FORMULAS

- **Incident Rate** is the rate of incidents occurring at schools and is calculated by dividing the number of incidents by the total number of students enrolled at the school. This rate may exceed 100% when the number of incidents is greater than the number of students enrolled.
- **Percent of Students Committing at Least One Incident** is calculated dividing the number of students who have committed at least one incident by the total number of students enrolled in school.
- **Percent of Students Committing Multiple Incidents** is calculated by dividing the number of students with more than one incident by the total number of students enrolled in school.
- **Suspension Rate** is calculated by dividing the total number of suspensions occurring at schools by the total number of students enrolled in school.
- **Percent of Students Suspended** is calculated by dividing the number of students receiving at least one suspension by the total number of students enrolled in school.
- **Percent of Students with Multiple Suspensions** is calculated by dividing the number of students that have received more than one suspension by the total number of students enrolled in school.
- **Suspension Rate by Suspension Type** is the rate at which a specific type of suspension (internal, external, or AES) occurs at schools and is calculated by dividing the number of suspensions of a specific type by the total number of students enrolled in school.
- **Percent of Students with Suspensions by Suspension Type** is calculated by dividing the number of students with a specific type of suspension (internal, external, or AES) by the total number of students enrolled at the school.
- **Internal Suspension** is a suspension where the student remains on campus but is not allowed to attend regularly scheduled classes for a determined period of time.
- **External Suspension** is a suspension where the student is not allowed to attend classes on any campus for a determined period of time.
- **AES, or Alternative to External Suspension**, is a suspension where the child is removed from campus but attends another BCPS site for a determined period of time.
- **Rate of Incidents Resulting in Suspension** shows how often a student who commits a specific incident type is suspended for committing that specific incident type and thus is a measure of how equitably suspensions are issued. This rate is calculated by dividing the number of suspensions issued for a specific type of incident by the total number of incidents of that same specific type.

III. DISTRICT TOTALS

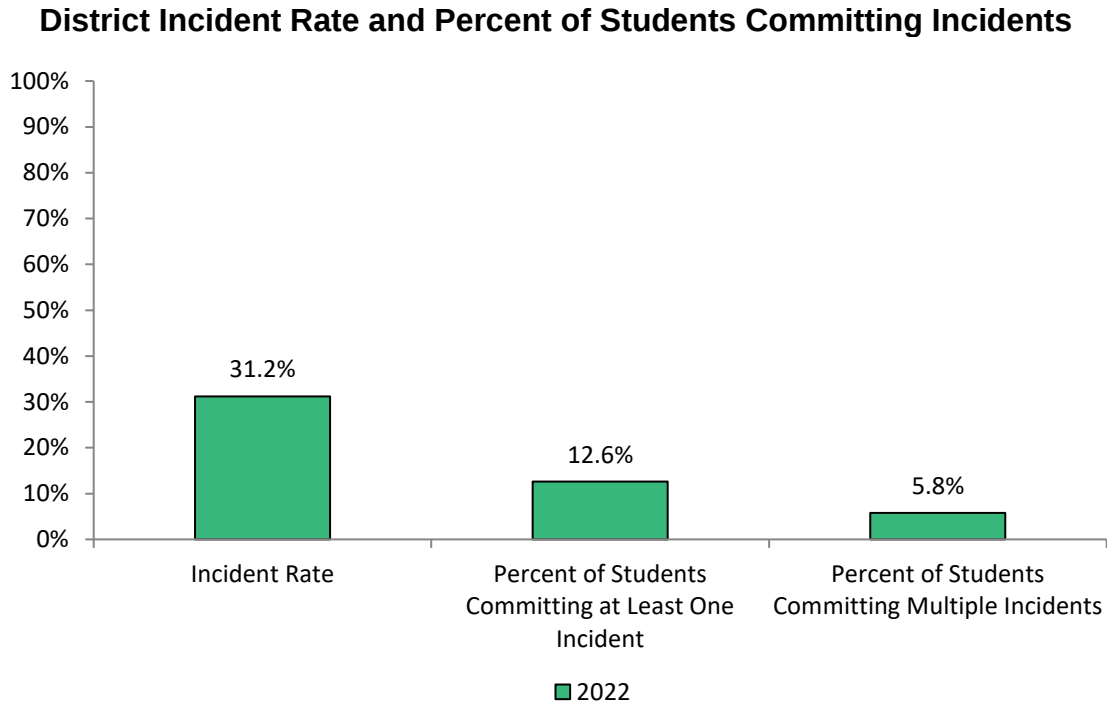


Figure 1. Incident rate and percent of students committing incidents Districtwide for the 2021-2022 school year.

Incident Rate and Percent of Students with Incidents. The incident rate in 2021-2022 was 31.2% and represents 82,707 incidents. In school year 2021-2022, the percent of students involved in at least one incident was 12.6% and students in multiple incidents was 5.8% (see Figure 1 and Appendix A-1 and Appendix A-2).

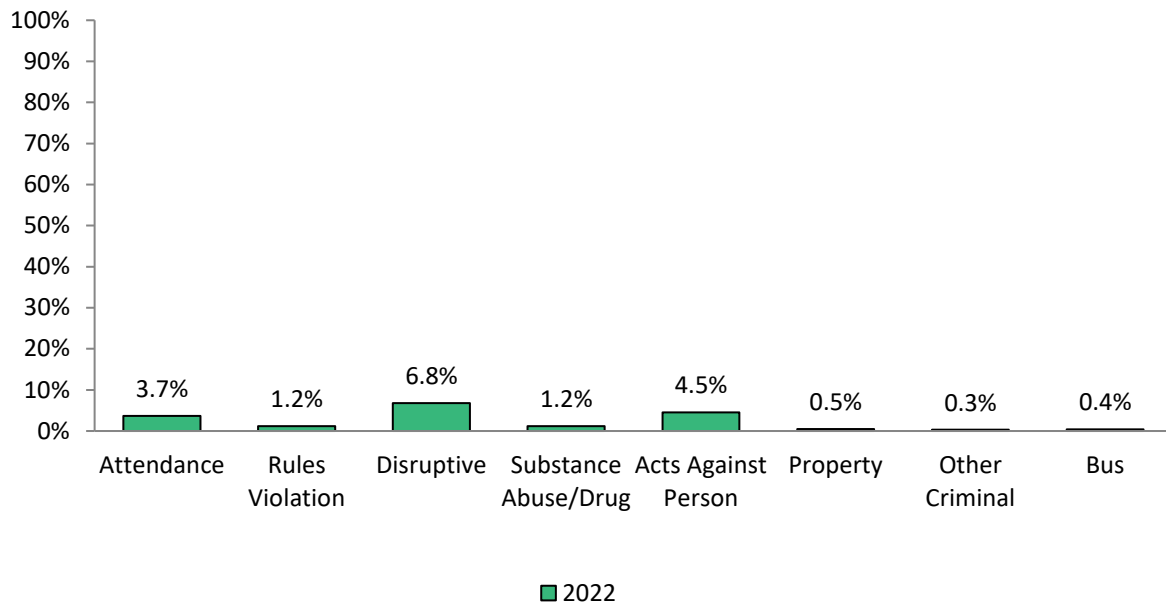


Figure 2. Percent of students committing incidents by incident type Districtwide for the 2021-2022 school year.

Incidents by Type. Figure 2 shows the percent of students overall who committed specific types of incidents over the past year. Disruptive incidents were registered by the largest percent of students across the District followed by acts against a person, and attendance for the 2021-2022 school year. For the past school year, disruptive incidents were the most frequently reported incident type (see Figure 2 and Appendix A-2).

District Percent of Students Committing Incidents by Incident Type

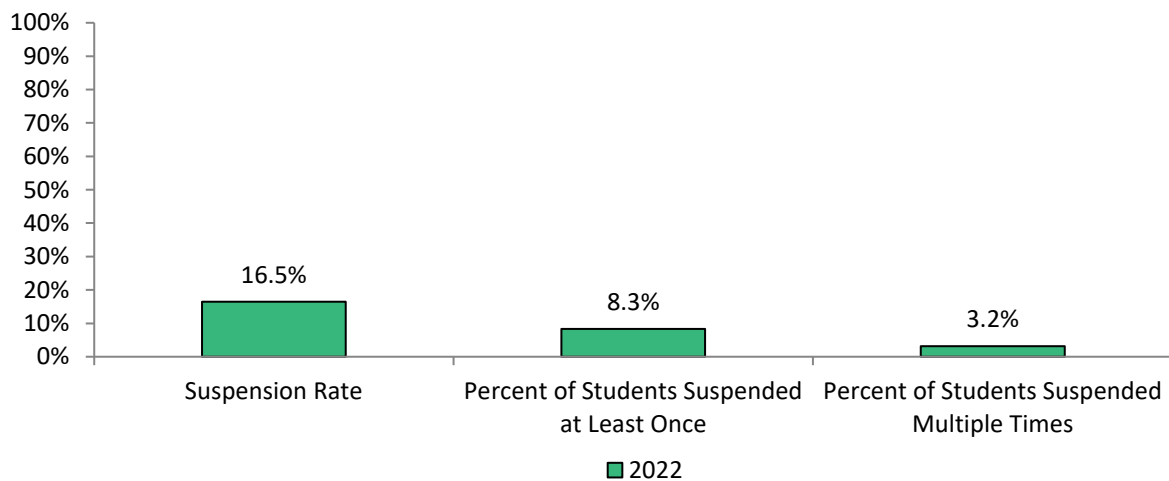


Figure 3. Suspension rate and percent of students suspended Districtwide for the 2021-2022 school year.

Suspension Rate and Percent of Students with Suspensions. The number of suspensions was 43,912 in 2021-2022 and the suspension rate was 16.5% in 2021-2022. The percent of students suspended at least once was 8.3% and the percent of students who received multiple suspensions was 3.2% (see Figure 3 and Appendix B).

District Suspension Rate and Percent of Students Suspended

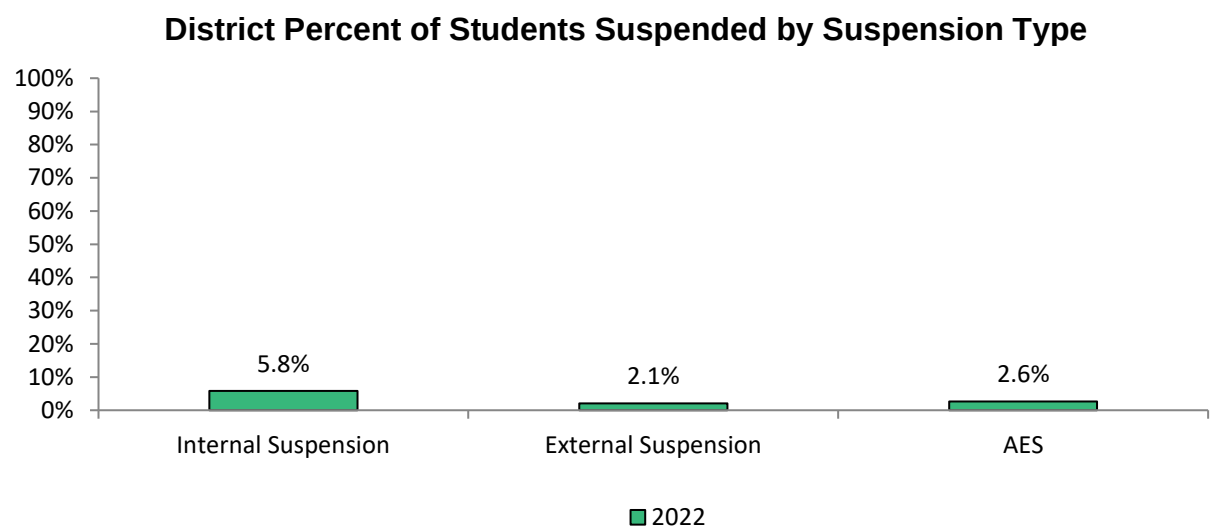


Figure 4. Percent of students receiving specific types of suspensions Districtwide for the 2021-2022 school year.

Suspensions by Type. About 8% of students received any type of suspension during the 2021-2022 school year. Internal suspensions were the most common type issued, with 5.8% of students receiving an internal suspension, followed by external suspension and AES, with 2.1% and 2.6% of students receiving this type of suspensions (see Figure 4 and Appendix B).

IV. DISTRICT TOTALS BY STUDENT RACE/ETHNICITY

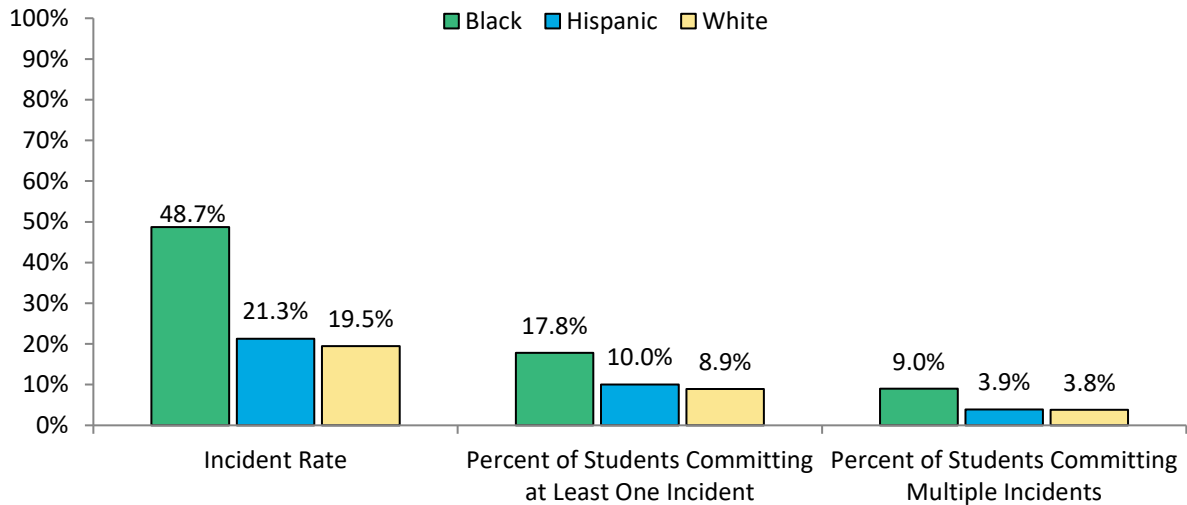


Figure 5. Districtwide Incident Rate and Percent of Students Committing Incidents by Race/Ethnicity for the 2021-2022 school year.

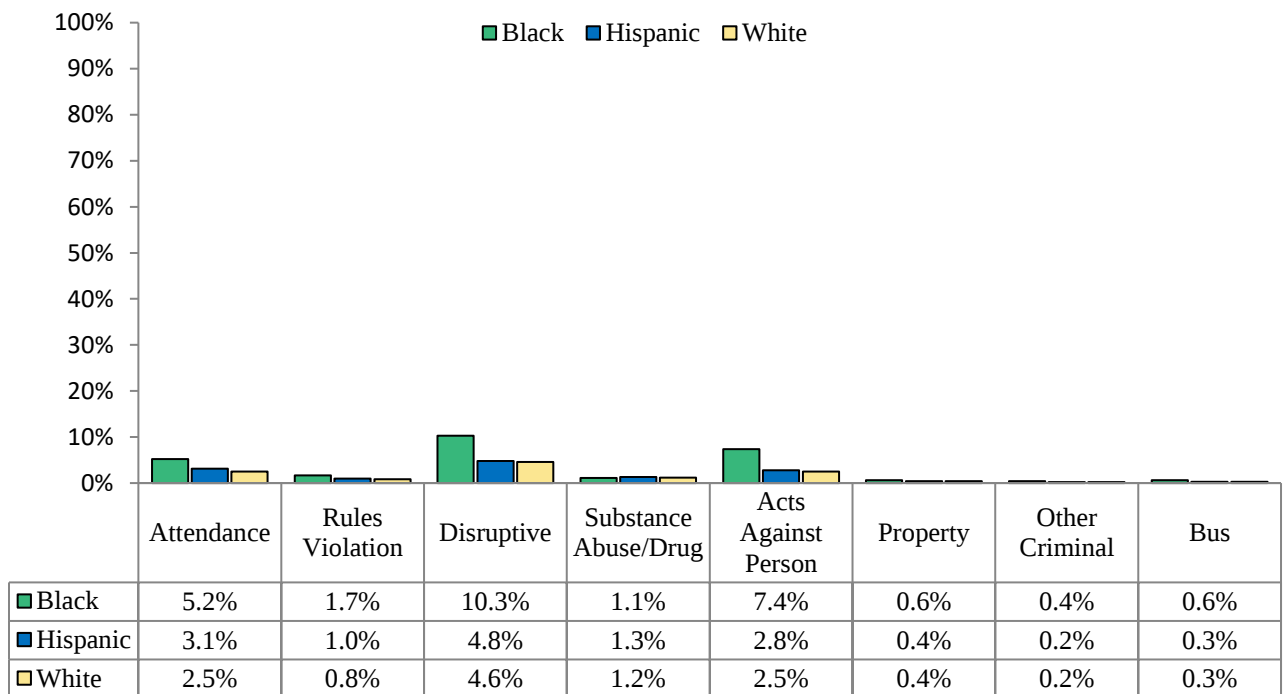


Figure 6. Districtwide percent of students with incidents by incident type by race/ethnicity for the 2021-2022 school year.

Incident Rate and Percent of Students with Incidents by Race/ethnicity. Black students registered the highest incident rate, with their incident rate more than two times higher than that of Hispanic and White students (see Figure 5, Appendix C-1 and Appendix C-2). Across all racial and ethnic groups, disruptive incidents were the most prevalent (see Figure 6 and Appendix C-1 and Appendix C-2).

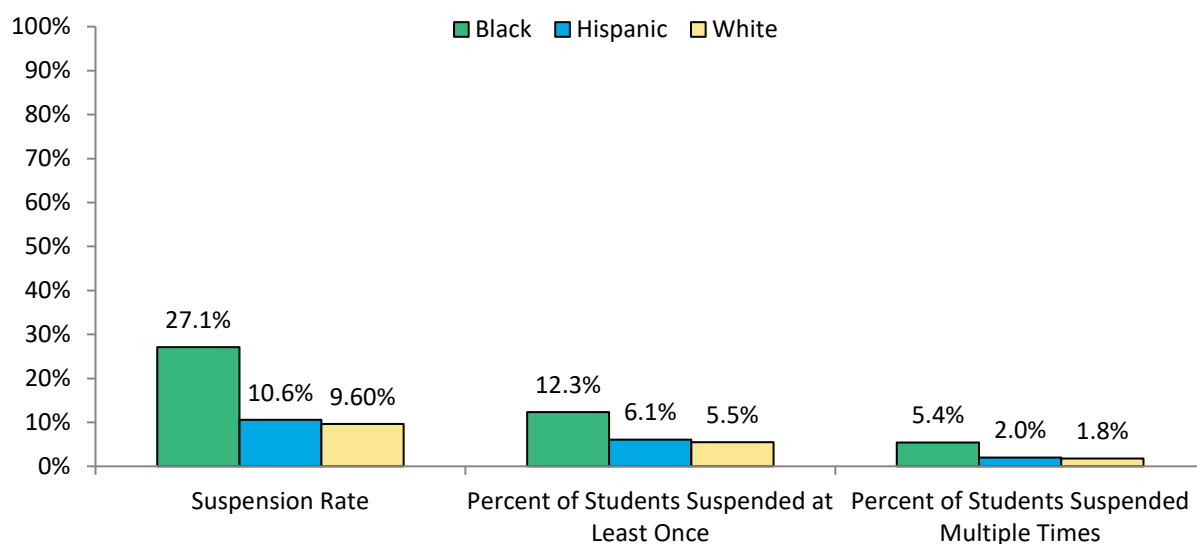


Figure 7. Suspension rate and percent of students suspended Districtwide by race/ethnicity for the 2021-2022 school year.

Suspension Rate and Percent of Students with Suspensions by Race/Ethnicity. As with incidents, the suspension rate was more than double for Black students compared to Hispanic and White students. During the most recently completed school year, 2021-2022,

the overall percent of Black students suspended was close to 12%, compared to around 6% for Hispanic and White students (see Figure 7 and Appendix D).

Suspensions by Type by Race/Ethnicity. Internal suspensions were the most frequent type of suspension issued and external suspensions were the least frequently issued. Approximately eight percent of Black, and less than 3% of Hispanic, and White students were suspended externally or through AES during the 2021-2022 school year (see Figure 8 and Appendix D).

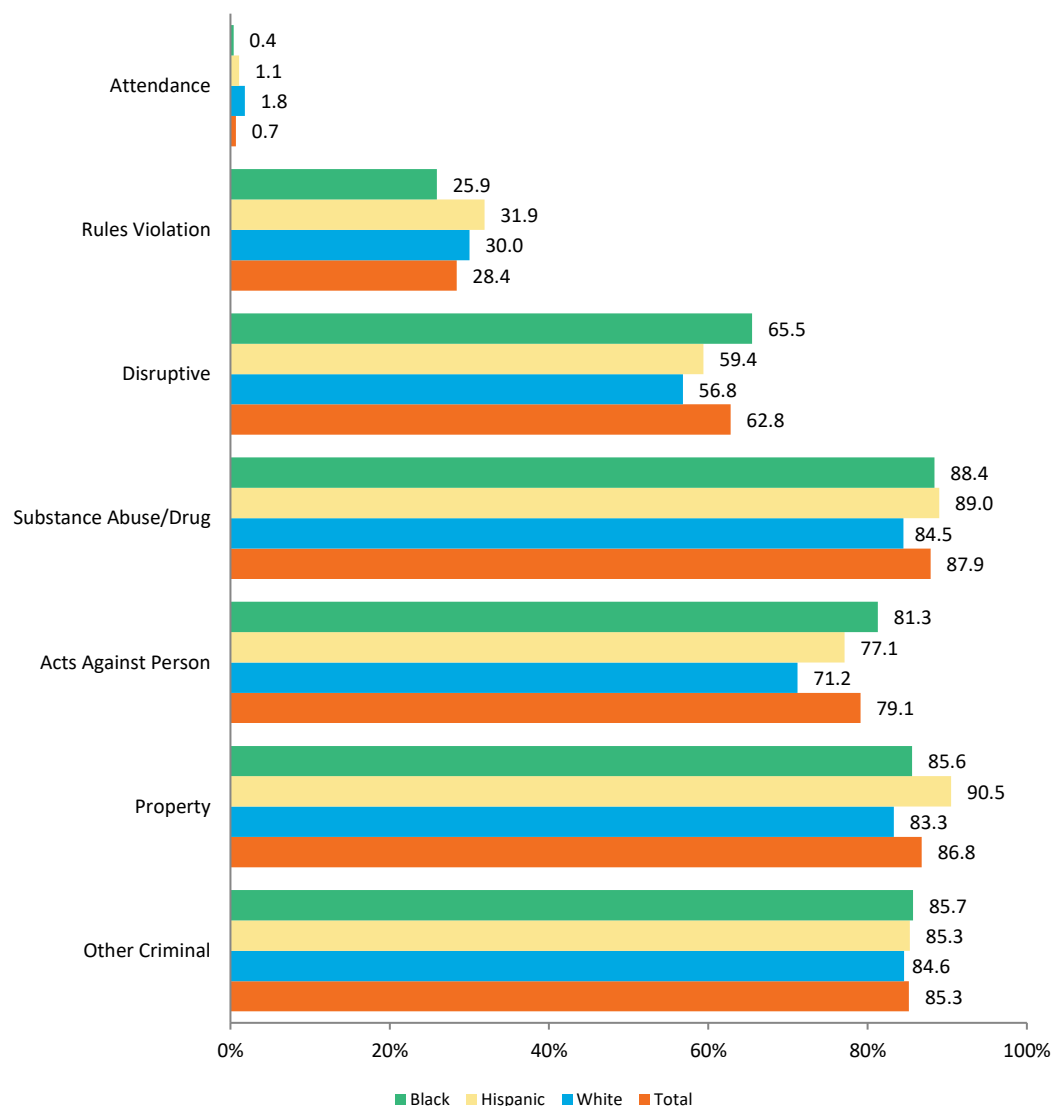


Figure 9. Rate of all incidents resulting in a suspension by race/ethnicity by specific incident type for the 2021-2022 school year.

Rate of Incidents Resulting in Suspension. In order to determine if suspensions were issued equitably among the three largest racial/ethnic groups, the rate of incidents resulting in suspension by incident type was calculated for Black, Hispanic, and White students. Figure 9 shows Black students were more frequently suspended than White students for disruptive (8.7 percentage points more), substance abuse/drug (3.9 percentage points more) and acts against a person (10.1 percentage points more)

incidents. White students were more frequently suspended than Black students for rules violations (4.1 percentage points more) (see also Appendix E). Hispanic students' rate of incidents resulting in a suspension fell between Black students' and White students' rates for all incident types. (see also Appendix E).

A one-way analysis of variance (ANOVA) was conducted to determine if these differences were statistically significant. Acts Against Persons incidents were statistically significant. Further analyses in Table 1 provides the specific incidents within the Acts Against Persons category.

V. SCHOOL LEVEL ANALYSIS

Incident Rate and Percent of Students Committing Incidents.

Elementary Schools

The number and rate of incidents at elementary schools in 2021-2022 were 15,845 incidents (13.6% incident rate). Disruptive incidents were the most prevalent, with 3.6% of all elementary school students registering at least one disruptive incident type. About 2% of elementary school students committed multiple incidents in the 2021-2022 school year. These data include all incidents (including those that did not result in suspensions; see also Appendices A-1 and A-2).

Middle Schools

The number and rate of incidents at middle schools in 2021-2022, were 37,316 incidents (60.2% incident rate). Disruptive incidents registered the largest percent of students, with 12.7% of all middle school students registering at least one disruptive incident type, followed by acts against person (9.0%), and attendance (5.3%). These data include all incidents (including those that did not result in suspensions; see also Appendices A-1 and A-2).

High Schools

The number and rate of incidents at high schools were 26,004 incidents (31.7% incident rate). During the 2021-2022 school year, attendance incidents and disruptive incidents registered the largest percent of students, with 7.1% at least one attendance incident type and 6.5% of all high school students registering at least one disruptive incident type, followed by acts against a person (3.3%). These data include all incidents (including those that did not result in suspensions; see also Appendices A-1 and A-2).

Center Schools

The number and rate of incidents at center schools were 3,542 incidents (78.6% incident rate). During the 2021-2022 school year, disruptive incidents registered the largest percent of students, with 13.6% of all center school students registering at least one disruptive incident type, followed by attendance (9.9%), and acts against a person (8.0%). These data include all incidents (including those that did not result in suspensions; see also Appendices A-1 and A-2). *Note, incident rate may exceed 100% when the number of incidents is greater than the number of students enrolled.*

Suspension Rate and Percent of Students with Suspensions.

Elementary Schools

During the 2021-2022 school year, the overall suspension rate at elementary schools was 3.7%, and the percent of students receiving at least one suspension of any type (internal, external, or AES) was 2.3%. Less than 1% of all elementary school students received an external suspension and less than 1% were suspended multiple times during the 2021-2022 school year (see also Appendix B).

Middle Schools

The rates for all types of suspensions at middle schools were 38.3% in 2021-2022. Also, 16.4% of students received at least one suspension, while 7.5% received multiple suspensions. Approximately 5% of all middle school students received an external suspension during the 2021-2022 school year (see Appendix B).

High Schools

These data indicate that the suspension rate at high schools in 2021-2022 was 16.7%. Also, during the 2021-2022 school year, 9.9% of students received at least one suspension, while 3.3% received multiple suspensions during the 2021-2022 school year (see also Appendix B).

Center Schools

During the 2021-2022 school year, the rates for all types of suspensions at center schools were 47.3%. Also, during the 2021-2022 school year, 19.8% of students received at least one suspension, while 9.7% received multiple suspensions (see also Appendix B).

VI. SCHOOL BY SCHOOL RESULTS

School level information for incidents and suspensions are available in the appendices. The number and rate of incidents by incident type are presented at the school level in Appendix F. Suspension information, including the number of suspensions and number of students suspended by suspension type and by race/ethnicity are presented in Appendix G.

VII. SUMMARY

Districtwide data on incidents and suspensions for students enrolled in district-managed and charter schools for the 2021-2022 school year was presented in this report. The overall incident rate was 31.2%. The percent of students committing incidents was 12.6%, with the percent of students committing multiple incidents at 5.8%.

Disruptive incidents were the most common incident type in school year 2021-2022, with 6.8% of students committing a disruptive incident. Acts against a person was the next most common (4.5%) followed by attendance (3.7%) and both rules violations and substance abuse/drug incidents (1.2%). The percentage of students committing property, other criminal, and bus incidents was 0.5% or less.

The suspension rate for 2021-2022, was 16.5%. The percent of students suspended was 8.3%. The percent of students suspended multiple times was 3.2%. Internal suspensions were the most common type issued, with 5.8% of students receiving an internal suspension, followed by external suspension (2.1%) and AES with and 2.6% of students receiving this type of suspensions.

Black students registered a higher incident rate (48.7%; with 17.8% percent of students committing at least one incident) than Hispanic (21.3%, with 10.0% percent of students committing at least one incident) and White (19.5% with 8.9% of students committing at least one incident) students. Black students were suspended at higher rates than White students for disruptive and acts against a person incident by 8.7 and 10.1 percent points. White students were suspended at higher rates than Black students for rules violations. Black, Hispanic, and White students were suspended at similar rates (less than 3% difference) for all other incident types. Hispanic students' rate of incidents resulting in a suspension fell between Black students' and White students' rates for all incident types.

VIII. DISCUSSION

The District has taken steps to ensure objectivity when determining disciplinary actions for students. The Discipline Matrix, which was introduced during the 2004-2005 school year, was developed to assist school staff in making fair and equitable decisions related to the assignment and reporting of punitive actions (see Appendix H for a listing of incident categories and types of incidents that fall within them). Schools are required by School Board Policy 5006: Suspension and Expulsion and School Board Policy 5.8a: Code of Student Conduct Handbook 2021-2024 to use the Discipline Matrix as their guide in determining appropriate consequences for student incidents (School Board of Broward County, 2022a). There are four Discipline Matrices (Grades K-2, 3-5, 6-8 and 9-12) so student behavior can be addressed in a more age-appropriate and social and emotional manner.

Three years after the recovery efforts from the Marjory Stoneman Douglas incident the District continues to stand strong and has taken the opportunity to strengthen existing supports for student misbehavior in a more comprehensive manner. Through the Mental Health Assistance Allocation Plan, the award of the Broward Comprehensive Universal Reduction of Violence (BCURV) and the School Violence (STOP) grants, the District has been able to provide wraparound services and resources to students and schools. With the addition of 10 Positive Behavior Intervention Specialists, the District has increased its capacity to better support the social-emotional and behavioral health needs of students, as well as strategically align critical climate resources to schools.

In addition to this more robust behavior intervention support, the District specifically scaled up pro-social campaign and awareness efforts related to social media usage during the Coronavirus pandemic for student e-learning. These efforts help to support the reduction efforts of student disciplinary violations.
