SUBJECT: FLORIDA SCHOOL GRADES, BASED ON 2020-21 ASSESSMENT DATA

Today, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) has released school grades, district grades, and school improvement ratings on the FDOE's website at

https://www.fldoe.org/accountability/accountability-reporting/school-grades/.

To be eligible to apply to opt in for a school grade, a school must have tested at least 90 percent of its eligible students. As stated in DOE Order No 2021-EO-02, performance data for all schools is reported, with the grade or rating excluded for those schools and districts that chose not to opt in. The Know Your Schools (<a href="https://www.KnowYourSchoolsFL.org">www.KnowYourSchoolsFL.org</a>) reporting tool will be updated with the 2020-2021 data by the end of the month. Additionally, by the end of the month, BCPS staff can view and interact with the school grade data through the Department's School Grades Insight dashboard available on the SharePoint link below:
