SUBJECT: 2021-2022 STATEWIDE SCIENCE AND SOCIAL STUDIES ASSESSMENT RESULTS

On Thursday, June 30, 2022, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released the official Spring 2021-2022 Science and Social Studies assessment results for:

- End-of-Course (EOC) Assessments (Biology, Civics, US History); and
- Statewide Science Assessments for grades 5 and 8.

This memorandum summarizes the results at the state and district levels. Individual student level results will be provided to each school through data folder access. Additionally, scores will be available to parents through the *Virtual Counselor* application at sso.browardschools.com. Internal dashboards (bit.ly/BCPSdashboards) on State Exams (bit.ly/BCPSsa), FSA/EOC Sub-scores (bit.ly/BCPSsa) and other topics will be updated next week.

These scores provide teachers, principals, instructional support personnel and the community with an achievement baseline to make decisions in supporting grade level instruction and gauge student growth.

The 2021-2022 results show that in all five tested areas the percentage of Broward's students scoring at or above achievement level 3 increased from the prior year. Specifically, Social Studies EOC performance increased noticeably with a ten percentage point increase for Civics and a seven percentage point increase for US History.

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A summary of the results for 2021-2022 and the change from the 2020-2021 results are provided below. The change from 2020-2021 results is indicated in parentheses.

- The percentage of students meeting or exceeding grade level satisfactory performance (achievement level 3 and above) on the Statewide Science Assessments is:
 - 44% in Grade 5 (+4 points)

- 40% in Grade 8 (+4 points)
- The percentage of students meeting or exceeding grade level satisfactory performance (achievement level 3 and above) on End-of-Course exams is:
 - o 59% in Biology (+1 points)

o 64% in US History (+7 points)

o 68% in Civics (+10 points)

State level, and other large district performance, is provided in the table below by assessment instrument. The table provides 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 results on the Statewide Science Assessments and Social Studies EOC tests. The data are summarized for Broward County Public Schools and the four other largest school districts in the state (Hillsborough, Miami-Dade, Orange and Palm Beach), as well as Florida overall.
