

- During both the 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 school years, PSAT/NMSQT, the District's overall scale score mean was lower than the state and national Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW), Math, and Total scale scores means.
- EBRW and Math District scale score means in 10th grade were lower than National and State during both years, and in 11th grade, scale score means were lower than the State and National during 2023-2024 but higher than the State and lower than the National for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Participation in 9th grade increased by 7.8%, 10th graders' participation increased by 6.8%; however, 11th graders' percentage decreased by 16.6%, and 12th graders' rate decreased by 2.3% compared to the 2023-2024 academic year.
- Out of 37,707 students that tested, 19,415 (51.49%) across all grades needed to meet math concordance for graduation, and 2,298 (11.8%) met the concordance graduation requirement through PSAT showing a lower percentage than the 2023-24 school year where out of 41,970 that tested, 34,458 (82.1%) needed to meet concordance and 4,723 students met concordance (13.7%).
- Out of a total of 21,627 students in 10th and 11th grades, 59.7% met the EBRW benchmark, 28.5% met the Math benchmark, and 26.3% met both benchmarks during the 2024-2025 school year showing growth from 2023-2024 school year where out of 25,123 students that tested in both grades, 50.2% met the EBRW benchmark, 24.7% met the Math benchmark, and 23.3% met both benchmarks.

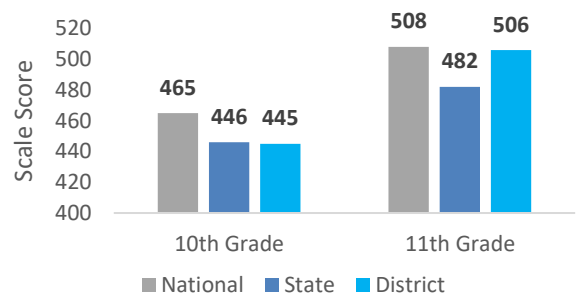

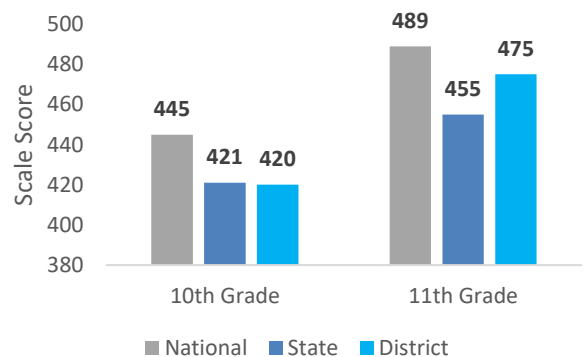

SUBJECT: PRELIMINARY SAT/NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFYING TEST SCHOOL YEARS 2023-2024 AND 2024-2025

This memo, the snapshot, and the attached appendices summarize student participation and scores from the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT), offered during the school years 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 to ninth, tenth, and eleventh-grade students, and to a small number of twelfth-grade students.

The PSAT/NMSQT is administered by the College Board and provides essential feedback to students, educators, and parents on reading, writing, and mathematical skills essential for success in college-level coursework. Additionally, the PSAT/NMSQT provides students with early exposure to a college entrance-type test (like the SAT) and helps educators identify students to compete in the National Merit Scholarship Competition, as well as identify students who may benefit from advanced course opportunities. The College Board provides an "Insights" report that assists teachers in identifying specific skill gaps and where additional instruction is needed. The College Board also provides a question-by-question breakdown that shows which questions each student is struggling with and where within the test they may be losing stamina, impacting their overall score.

The Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) covers the cost of participation for all 10th-grade students to eliminate obstacles to participation by underrepresented groups. During the 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 school years, the District covered the cost of participation for all 9th-grade students and 12th-grade students who needed to meet Algebra concordance for graduation in traditional schools and centers. Participating students in other grades must pay to participate in the PSAT/NMSQT or have their participation paid for by the school in which they are enrolled. A summary of PSAT/NMSQT outcomes is provided below, and data summaries can be found in the appendices.

Grade-level Benchmarks: Students who take the PSAT/NMSQT can see grade-level benchmarks on their score reports. Grade-level benchmarks indicate whether students are on track for college and career readiness.

Beginning in the school year 2018-2019, scores of 430 or higher on the Math section of the PSAT/NMSQT earned concordance for the Algebra I graduation requirement.

The following testing results are retrieved from the test administration period of the PSAT/NMSQT Day during October 2023 and October 2024:

1. National, State, and District differences according to College Board data. (See Appendix E).
 - a. **Overall:** During both 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 school years, the District's overall scale score mean was lower than the State and National means for PSAT/NMSQT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW), Math, and Total scale score means.
 - b. **10th Grade:**
 - The District's Total scale score mean was lower than the State and National during both school years, 2023-2024 and 2024-2025. However, there is growth from one year to another.
 - The District EBRW scale score mean was lower than the National scale score, but it was the same as the State during the 2023-2024 school year. During the 2024-2025 school year, the EBRW scale score mean was lower than the State and National, however, there is growth from one year to another.
 - The District's average Math scale score was lower than both the State and National averages in the 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 school years, with no growth observed between the two years.
 - c. **11th Grade:**
 - The District's Total, EBRW, and Math scale score means were lower than State and National during the 2023-2024 school year; however, during the 2024-2025 school year, the scale score means were higher than the State but lower than National, with growth from one year to another.
2. Students included in participation and performance data during the October 2023 and October 2024 PSAT testing window are grades 9 to 11 students in traditional and center schools; 10th grade students in charter schools; and 12th graders needing concordance for graduation.
 - a. **Participation by Grade Level:**
 - For 9th graders in 2024-2025, out of 16,919 students enrolled, 14,751 participated (87.2%), showing an increase of 7.8% compared to 2023-2024 (79.4%)
 - For 10th graders in 2024-2025, out of 19,519 students enrolled, 16,737 participated (85.7%), showing an increase of 6.8% compared to 2023-2024 (78.9%)
 - For 11th graders in 2024-2025, out of 17,529 students enrolled, 4,890 participated (27.9%), showing a decrease of 16.6% compared to 2023-2024 (44.5%).
 - For 12th graders in 2024-2025, out of 18,384 students enrolled, 1,329 participated (7.2%), showing a decrease of 2.3% compared to 2023-2024 (9.5%). (see Appendix A).
 - b. **Participation by Grade Level by Race in 2023-2024:**
 - Participation rates for 9th-grade White (80.4%) and Black (78.3%) students differed by 2.1%, and White students' participation compared to Hispanic (79.6%) students differed by less than 1%.
 - Tenth-grade student participation rates were higher for White students (82.0%) compared to Black (75.6%) by 6.4% and Hispanic (79.6%) students by 2.4%.
 - White students in 11th grade had a participation rate of 43.1%, 4.1% lower than Black students (47.2%) but 2.2% higher than Hispanic students (40.9%). (see Appendix B).
 - c. **Participation by Grade Level by Race in 2024-2025:**
 - Participation rates for 9th-grade White (89.1%) and Black (84.5%) students differed by 4.6%, and White students' participation compared to Hispanic (88.4%) students differed by less than 1%.

- Tenth grade student participation rates were higher for White students (89.2%) compared to Black (83.0%) by 6.2% and Hispanic (86.3%) students by 2.9%.
 - White students in 11th grade had a participation rate of 33.0%, 8.6% higher than Black students (24.4%) and 6.4% higher than Hispanic students (26.6%). (see Appendix B).
3. For the 2024-2025 academic year, out of 37,707 students that tested, 19,415 (51.49%) students across all grades **needed to meet math concordance** for graduation, and 2,298 (11.8%) scored 430 or higher on the Math section to meet the concordance graduation requirement showing a lower percentages than the 2023-2024 school year where out of 41,970 students that tested, 34,458 (82.1%) needed to meet concordance and 4,723 (13.7%) students met concordance through the PSAT/NMSQT. (see Appendices F, G, H, I, J, and K).

a. Math Concordance for Graduation by Grade Levels

- For the 2023-2024 school year, 1,441 out of 34,458 (4.2%) and for the 2024-2025 school year, 879 out of 19,415 (4.5%) of 9th-grade students met the Math concordance requirement for graduation through the PSAT/NMSQT.
 - For the 2023-2024 school year, 1,170 out of 34,458 (3.4%) and for the 2024-2025 school year, 796 out of 19,415 (4.1%) of 10th-grade students met the Math concordance requirement for graduation through the PSAT/NMSQT.
 - For the 2023-2024 school year, 1,927 out of 34,458 (5.6%) and for the 2024-2025 school year, 437 out of 19,415 (2.2%) of 11th-grade students met the Math concordance requirement for graduation through the PSAT/NMSQT.
 - For the 2023-2024 school year, 185 out of 34,458 (0.5%) and for the 2024-2025 school year, 186 out of 19,415 (1.0%) of 12th-grade students met the Math concordance requirement for graduation through the PSAT/NMSQT.
4. PSAT/NMSQT EBRW and Math benchmarks cut scores are calculated only for students in 10th and 11th grades by the College Board.

a. Overall PSAT Performance:

- Out of a total of 21,627 students in 10th and 11th grades, 59.7% met the EBRW benchmark, 28.5% met the Math Benchmark, and 26.3% met both benchmarks during the 2024-25 school year. In contrast to the 2023-2024 school year, where out of 25,123 students that tested in both grades, 50.2% met the EBRW benchmark, 24.7% met the Math benchmark, and 23.3% met both benchmarks.

b. PSAT Performance by Grade Levels:

- During the 2024-2025 school year, the percentage rate of students meeting EBRW benchmark for 10th grade (57.5%) and 11th grade (67.2%) showed performance growth from last academic year, 2023-2024, by 6.4% difference for 10th graders and by 18.8% difference for 11th graders. (see Figure 1).
- Compared to the last academic year, the percentage rate of students meeting the Math benchmark for 10th grade (25.6%) showed consistency with less than 1% increase; however, 11th-grade (38.7%) students' performance showed growth by 15.6% (see Figure 2).

c. PSAT Performance by Race by Grade Level: Percentage rates of White students meeting EBRW and Math benchmarks were higher than Hispanic and Black students in 10th and 11th grades during the 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 school years. (See Figures 3 and 4, and Tables 1 and 2).

- The gap between White and Hispanic students in 10th grade meeting EBRW benchmark was 15.1 points in 2023-2024 and 16.2 points difference in 2024-2025; and in 11th grade was 21.8 points in 2023-2024 and 13.3 points in 2024-2025; and in meeting Math benchmark in 10th grade was 14.8 points in 2023-2024 and 15.5 points in 2024-2025 and in 11th grade was 20.2 in 2023-2024 and 15.2 points in 2024-2025.
- The gap between White and Black students in 10th grade meeting EBRW benchmark was 30.5 points in 2023-2024 and 28.5 points in 2024-2025, and in 11th grade was 34.9 points in 2023-2024 and 28.8 points in 2024-2025; and in meeting Math benchmark in 10th grade was 27.9 points in 2023-2024 and 24.3 points in 2024-2025 and in 11th grade was 31.5 points in 2023-2024 32.8 points in 2024-2025.

d. **PSAT Performance by Gender by Grade Level:**

- Females' percentage rates in meeting EBRW benchmarks in 10th grade were higher than men by 4.4 points in 2023-2024 and 5.1 points in 2024-2025, and in 11th grade by 4.1 points in 2023-2024 and 4.2 points in 2024-2025.
- Males' percentage rates in meeting Math benchmarks in 10th grade were higher than females by 1.8 points in 2023-2024 and by 2.4 points in 2024-2025, and in 11th grade by 4.3 points in 2023-2024 and 5.0 points in 2024-2025. (See Figures 5 and 6, and Tables 1 and 2).

e. **PSAT Performance by Race by Gender by Grade Level:**

- During both school years, White males in 10th grade had a higher percentage rate in meeting both benchmarks compared to Hispanic males by 12.6 points in 2023-2024 and 16.8 points in 2024-2025 and Black males by 28.2 points in 2023-2024 and 29.0 points in 2024-2025, and in 11th grade, White males had a higher percentage rate in meeting both benchmarks as well compared to Hispanic males by 22.1 points in 2023-2024 and 12.8 points in 2024-2025 and Black males by 35.3 points in 2023-2024 and by 38.1 points in 2024-2025.
- During both school years, White females in 10th grade also had a higher percentage rate in meeting both benchmarks compared to Hispanic females by 15.2 points in 2023-2024 and by 14.8 points in 2024-2025 and Black females by 25.0 points in 2023-2024 and 23.0 points in 2024-2025, and in 11th grade, White females had a higher percentage rate than Hispanic females by 18.6 points in 2023-2024 and 18.7 points in 2024-2025 and Black females by 27.7 points in 2023-2024 and by 31.2 points in 2024-2025. Students who Met the EBRW Benchmark

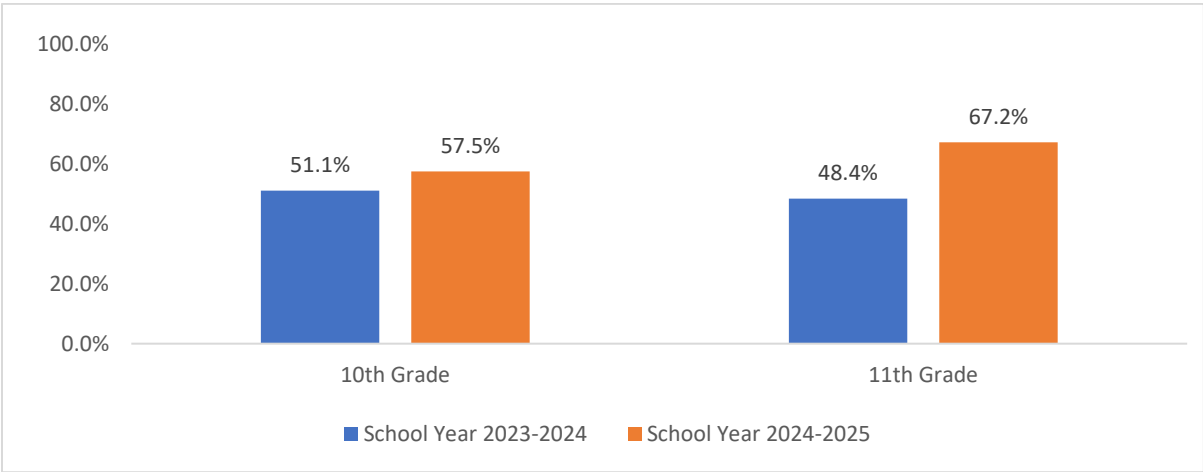

Students who Met the Math Benchmark

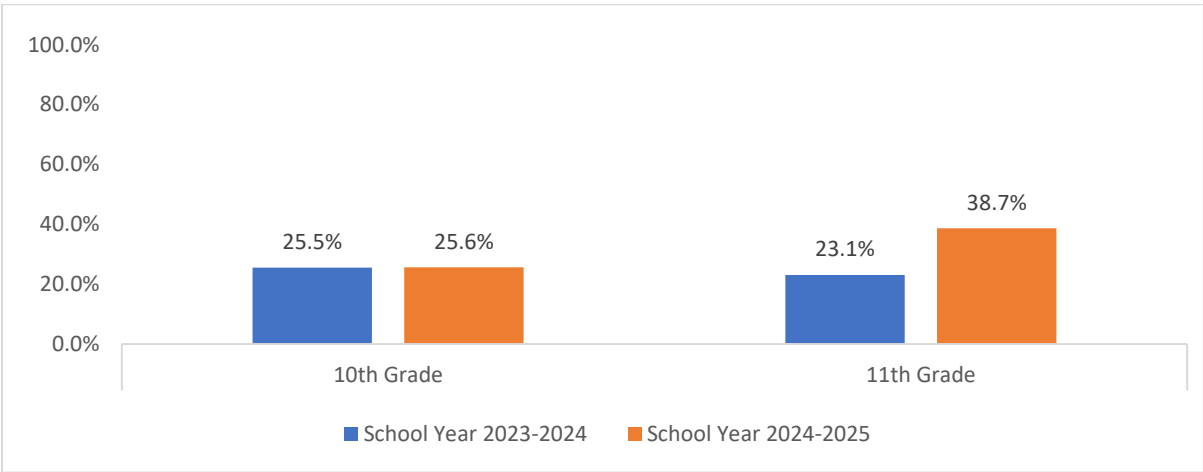

Percentage of Students who Met PSAT/NMSQT Benchmarks by Race/Ethnicity during the 2023-2024 school year

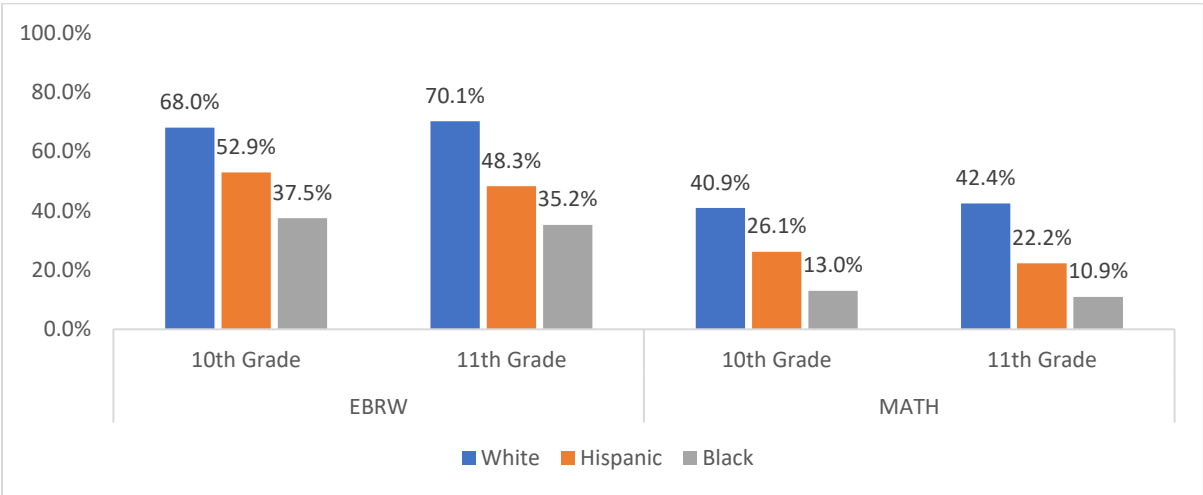

Percentage of Students who Met PSAT/NMSQT Benchmarks by Race/Ethnicity during the 2024-2025 school year

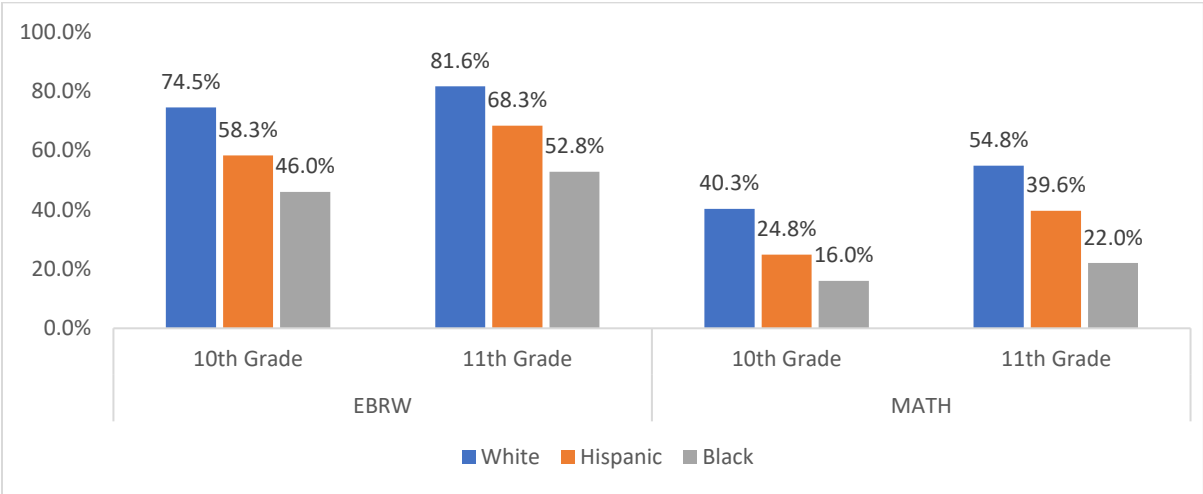

Percentage of Students who Met PSAT/NMSQT Benchmarks by Gender during the 2023-2024 school year

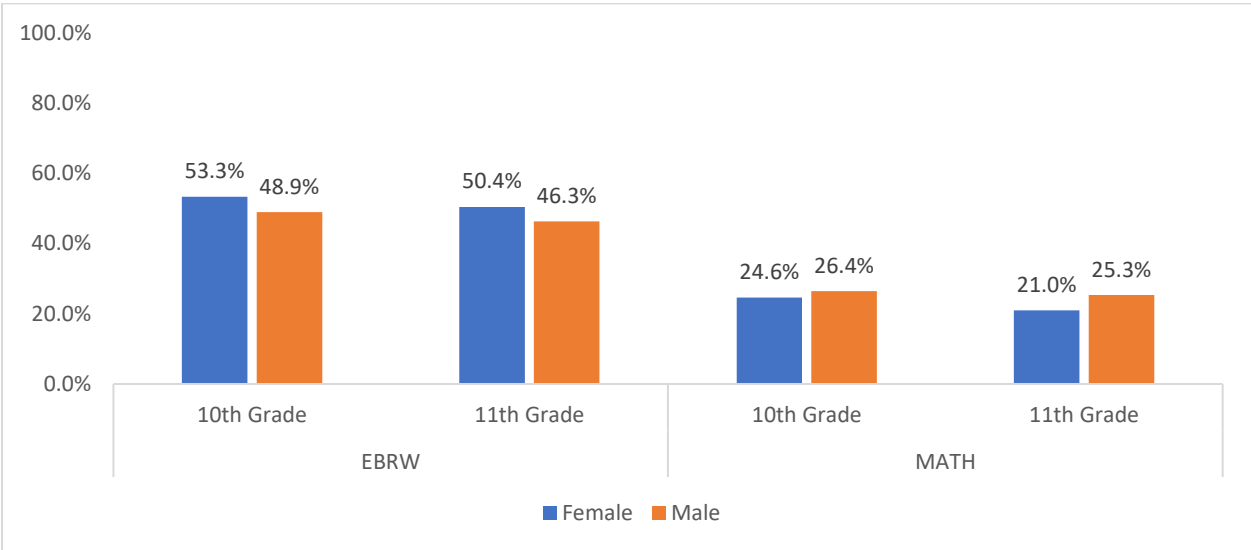

Percentage of Students who Met PSAT/NMSQT Benchmarks by Gender during the 2024-2025 school year

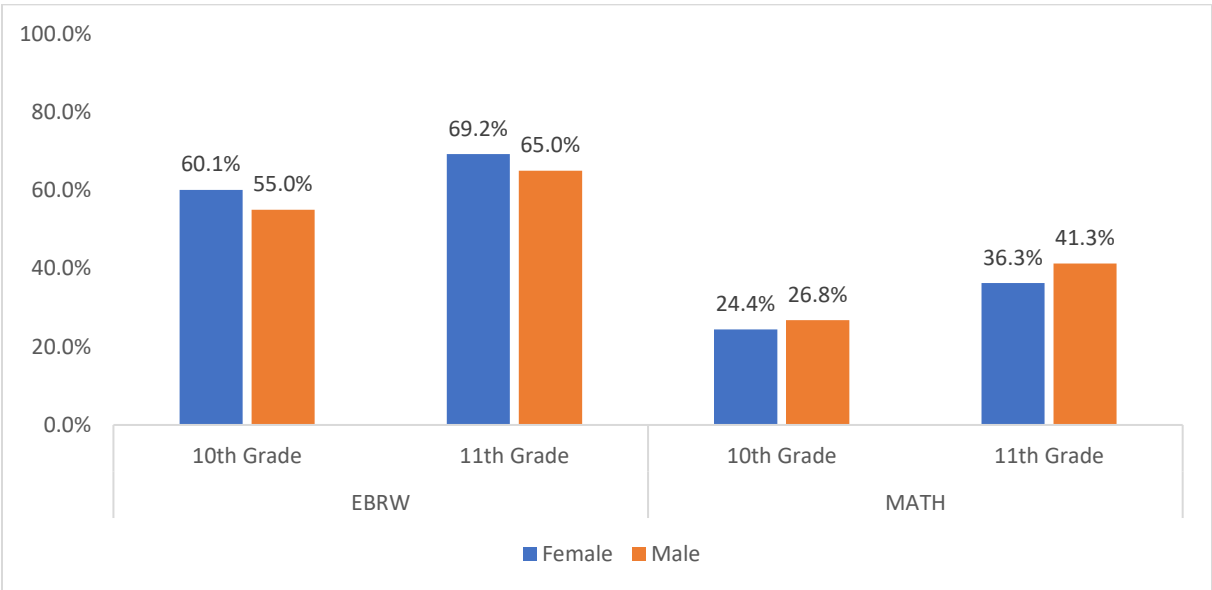
