IMPORTANT NOTE

- All paper-based administrations of the FSA Writing/Reading/Mathematics or FCAT
 2.0 Science components must be administered on the days specified above.
- For initial OR make-up test administrations, Session 1 MUST be administered before session 2 or 3.

COMPUTER-BASED TEST ADMINISTRATIONS

Please see the scheduling guidance below for each computer-based test (CBT).

RETAKES

The administration window for Spring Retakes is **February 25 – March 15, 2019.** CBT sessions may be scheduled during the entire Retake window.

- Algebra 1 FSA EOC Retake: The FSA-aligned Algebra 1 EOC
 assessment is administered in two, 90-minute sessions. Students may
 have up to half a school day (3–3.5 hours) to complete.
- FSA ELA Language Arts (Writing) Grade 10 Retake: The FSA ELA Grade 10 Writing Retake is administered in one, 120-minute session. Students may have up to half a school day (3–3.5 hours) to complete. This should take place prior to take the reading and listening portion of the retake.
- FSA ELA Language Arts (Reading and Listening) Grade 10 Retake. The FSA ELA Grade 10 Reading Retake is administered in two sessions over two days. Students are scheduled for 90 minutes per session but may have up to half the length of a typical school day (3–3.5 hours) to complete each session.

FSA ELA and Math CBT ASSESSMENTS

Grades 7–10 FSA ELA Writing will be administered in one, 120 -minute session from April 1–5, with makeups continuing through April 12.

7 and 8 FSA ELA Reading will be administered in two, 85-minute sessions over two days.

Grades 7 and 8 FSA Mathematics will be administered in three, 60-minute sessions over two days. Session 1 must be assessed on day 1 and sessions 2 and 3 on day 2. Remember that if Hand Held Calculators are provided, it would only be for sessions 2 and 3 (Day 2).

Grades 9 & 10 FSA ELA Reading will be administered in two, 90-minute sessions over two days.

CBT ELA and Math Testing Window (May 1- May 29)

• **Middle and High**: Schools may begin administering Computer based assessments to grade 7–10 starting on May 1.

FSA EOC Assessments.

Algebra 1 and Geometry FSA EOC will be administered in two, 90-minute sessions over two days. Any student not finished by the end of the 90-minute session may have half the length of a typical school day to finish (3–3.5 hours).

NGSSS Aligned EOC CBT ASSESSMENTS

Biology 1, US History and Civics EOC assessments will be administered in one, 160-minute session given in one day. If additional time is needed it may be provided up until the end of the school day.

CBT NGSSS EOC Testing Window (May 1 – May 29)

Paper Based Accommodations

Paper-based accommodations (regular print, large print, and braille) for CBT administrations will be provided for eligible students, as indicated on student IEPs or Section 504 plans. Paper-based accommodations should be administered within the first one or two weeks of testing for any CBT window. There will be specific instructions on returning paper materials to ensure scores from those assessments are not reported late.

The Student Assessment and Research and Exceptional Student Education Departments require that schools submit documentation that the student's IEP indicates the need for paper materials on standardized assessments.

No deviation from the established FSA/FCAT 2.0 administration schedule is allowed without written approval from the FDOE prior to implementation.

Calibration Schools

Selected calibration schools for Grades 7–10 ELA or Grades 7 Mathematics are required to administer the selected grade level ELA Reading or Mathematics test during the first week of the Computer Based Testing window (May 1–10).

Grades 7-10 calibration and non-calibration schools will administer ELA Writing according to the districtwide testing calendar.
