The Broward P₃ Eco-Challenge initiative is a multi-divisional and organizational effort among the Applied Learning Department of the Office of Academics, Environmental Health & Safety Department, and Information & Technology Department of BCPS, and their partners, Broward County Environmental Planning & Community Resilience Division and the Environmental Conservation Organization (ECO).

P₃ School Challenge – BCPS traditional and charter schools that demonstrate participation in or implementation of different sustainability metrics based on a rubric composed of 6 comprehensive categories: School Grounds Enhancement, School Sustainability, Curriculum Integration, Community Involvement, Administrative Support, and Innovation. Schools may apply to all categories or any individual categories.
