BCPS Model PLC Schools Look Fors

The following should be evident in an authentic Professional Learning Community:

- An agenda was sent out prior or presented during the PLC.
- Members of the PLC discussed norms established for the PLC.
- Adult Learning Principles were implemented.
- One or more of the PLC Big Ideas were addressed.
- PLC Facilitator provided a supportive environment for their team.
- Team roles were used during the session.
- Protocols were used to facilitate the PLC work.
- PLC focused on curriculum, assessment, remediation, and/or enrichment (CARE).
- PLC members participated through collective inquiry and active discussion.
- A culture of collaboration was displayed.
- A PLC structure (Collaborative Inquiry, Data Teams, Lesson Study, or Action Research) was used during the CARE cycle.
- Implementation practices were discussed and planned.
