Notes from Fourth Grade

Classes will intensively review all FSA Standards prior to the tests.

Reading: Students will be reading the <u>Last Egret</u>, a book about the Florida Great Bird Expedition. Students will be focusing on theme, cause and effect, character traits, story elements, and historical references.

Math: Students will be preparing for 5th Grade Standards to include place value to the ten millions, dividing multiples of ten, using order of operations, finding sums of decimal amounts in dollars and cents, and using multiplication to describe a pattern. Students will be exposed to rounding decimals, including money amounts to the nearest whole number or dollar. Students will be shown how to use place value to read, write and represent decimals. Students will use place value top compare decimals.

Science: To tie into our unit on the <u>Last Egret</u>, students will focus on seasonal changes of Florida organisms. Later in the month we will focus on the physical sciences through hands on experiments. Students will learn about energy, heat and motion.

Social Studies: Students will read document-based information about the Everglades. They will learn about the Everglades and how development has affected it and endangered certain species. A power point on the Everglades will be assigned and presented
