#### What's Happening in...

#### Reading ~ Comprehension

Students will also continue working on reading comprehension by asking and answering questions about key details in a text and working on identifying the main topic and retelling key details of a text. They will also learn how to write simple book reports. Students will continue taking Accelerated Reading Tests until May 10<sup>th</sup>, when the program closes.

#### Math ~ Getting Ready For First Grade

In Math we are reviewing all math standards and concepts we have learned throughout the year as preparation for the end of the year Math test. Students will then further develop skills in these various areas with more challenging work in such areas as addition and subtraction, counting on from a given number and comparing numbers.

**Science** ~ Students will be learning about the parts of seeds and parts of a plant. They will plant seeds and care for the plant as it grows.

<u>Social Studies</u> ~ Students will be learning about Needs & Wants, Economics and Careers, in preparation for Career Day.
