Look what we are learning!

READING: The students will continue to review all the reading standards for literature and informational text. They will use stories from the Journeys text and various chapter books to demonstrate proficiency of the standards.

WRITING: The students will begin to practice cursive writing skills this month. They will continue to write opinion pieces on a topic and use details to support their point of view, write informative and explanatory texts to examine a topic, and write a narrative to create a real or imagined story.

MATH: The students will review all of the math standards taught throughout the year. They will take 2 sessions of the FSA MATH assessment on May 7 and 8. Make sure your child eats a healthy breakfast and goes to bed early.

SCIENCE: The students will explore the law of gravity by demonstrating that gravity is a force that can be overcome. They will use science experiments to show examples of how to overcome gravity.

SOCIAL STUDIES: The students will continue to learn about economy. They will learn how scarcity results in trade and how buyers and sellers interact to exchange goods and services through the use of trade or mone
