School starts promptly at **8:00 am**, please be on time!

The First Grade students will continue to understand and apply First grade skills, focusing on the Florida Standards.

In Reading, the students will engage in activities that will introduce text features and asking and answering questions to find meaning to unknown words. The students will also be able to tell the difference between picture and text information. The students will participate in Language Arts and Writing activities with an emphasis on Verbs and Prepositions. The students continue to receive differentiated instruction while participating in small groups.

In Math, we will continue working on subtracting within 20. The students will apply strategies such as counting back, using objects and/or drawings in order to understand the relationship between addition and subtraction. We are also using manipulatives and center activities to help reinforce these skills.

In Science, we will focus on Organization and Development of Living Organisms. The students will research and learn about animals and their life cycles and how different species of animals differ and are the same in how their life cycles are. In Social Studies, the students will learn about how life in the past differs from life now. They will continue to compare and contrast how history has effected how life is today. Students will continue to learn about history, specifically, American History.
