ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS (ELA)

The Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) test was taken in April. Students must score a level 2 on the FSA (ELA) to be promoted to 5th grade.

An alternative reading test will be administered before June to be used as an additional tool for promotion criteria.

We will continue to use and strengthen our ELA skills as we read the book:

The Last Egret:

The Adventures of Charlie Pierce.

"This story takes place in Florida during the 19th Century when bird feathers were used for ladies' fashion. Charlie Pierce and his friends traveled deep into the unexplored Florida Everglades to hunt plume birds for their feathers. They never imagined the challenges they would encounter, what they would learn about themselves, and how they would contribute to American history".

Please make sure your child continues to utilize I-Ready for a minimum of 45 minutes weekly in reading and math, with a passing accuracy rate of 75% or higher in preparation for 5th grade.

MATH
