



BACK TO SCHOOL, FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Davie Elementary

1. My child went to Davie Elementary last year, do I need to re-enroll him/her?

If your child's last day of school (KG – 4th grade) 2020-2021 was at Davie Elementary and will be returning to Davie Elementary, you do not need to re-enroll him.

*However, you **must complete** the Online Back to School Forms. Go to browardschools.com/bts. the process will take about 20 minutes per student. You will need their student number, and you will need access to email.*

2. My child is new to Davie Elementary, and I need to enroll or register my child, how do I do it and what documents do I need?

You may go to davie.browardschools.com to may obtain a list of what documents you will need to bring with you to register your child. From your computer or phone, please go to the School News section and scroll down to “How to Register for School”, then look for “

THE PARENTS OF NEW STUDENTS NEED TO COME TO THE FRONT OFFICE AND FILL OUT THE REGISTRATION FORM AND THE EMERGENCY CONTACT FORM. BELOW ARE THE DOCUMENTS THAT YOU WILL NEED TO BRING WITH YOU.

1. THE STUDENT HANDBOOK NEEDS TO BE FILLED OUT. YOU CAN DOWNLOAD A COPY OF THE HANDBOOK HERE. Forms that need to be signed are not at the beginning of the booklet. Scroll down to page xii to view the forms.

You do not need an appointment. Please stop by the school to complete registration Monday – Friday from 8:15 am – 1:15 pm. The office closes at 3:00 pm.

3. Will Davie Elementary be holding a Meet and Greet and Open House for Parents at the beginning of this school year?

On August 17, we will have our Title 1 Meeting/Open House/Meet and Greet in the classrooms. Your child's teacher will contact you via phone, email and/or text on

Monday afternoon to let you know their name and room number. Due to COVID concerns, we invite one parent per student to come to the classroom. Feel free to bring your child's supplies (suggested supply list on website). Remember that face coverings are mandatory for all students, staff and visitors at school and on the buses. Masks are not required outside while engaged in physical activity.

4. How do I find out who my child's teacher is and what gate do I drop and pick him up from?

Teachers will be contacting parents by Monday or Tuesday prior to the first day of school, Wednesday, August 18th. They will be introducing themselves and giving you all sorts of pertinent information regarding your child. Please make sure your contact information is up to date in our system and listen for Parent-links, emails and texts for communication from your child's teacher and/or Administration. At that time, the teachers will also be letting you know which gate to bring your child to and pickup at dismissal.

5. What are the school hours?

Schools will have instruction from 8:00 am – 2:00 pm (8:00 am – 12:00 pm on Early Release Days). Students should be in school by 7:55 am and must be in their seats by 8:00 am or they will be considered tardy.

The earliest you may drop off your child will be at 7:15 am. If your child is eating a free, healthy breakfast at school, please drop your child off starting at 7:15 am at Gate #1.

Office hours are 7:30 am – 3:00 pm. Due to COVID CDC guidelines, we are asking to please maintain your safety distance. Only one family will be permitted in the office at a time since we have a very small office. Remember that face coverings are mandatory for all students, staff and visitors while on campus. Your patience and cooperation is greatly appreciated.

6. Does Davie Elementary have Before Care or After School Care?

No, unfortunately Davie Elementary does not have either program at this time. We are currently in search of great after school care employees. We will continue our search and hope to find and hire after school care staff. Then we will send out an aftercare survey in mid to late September to gauge interest.

7. Dismissal Information: Parents must make arrangements to have their child picked up at 2:00 pm by a person listed on the Emergency Contact Card or you may also contact any of the After Care providers. Most of these providers have advised that they will pickup at Davie, but you must make arrangements directly with them. Then you must share your dismissal instructions with the classroom teacher. We will only follow the dismissal instructions you have written,

emailed or directly communicated with the classroom teacher. We will not release students to a private aftercare or to other people unless authorized by the parent.

8. Where can I get a list to purchase school supplies?

You will see a link on davie.browardschools.com under “School News”. There is a link for you to obtain a copy of the 2021-2022 Suggested School Supply list.

Great News! The Broward Education Foundation has graciously donated a “Basic School Supply Kit” for each child. The supply kit contains a few pencils, crayons, 1 eraser, 1 glue stick, 1 spiral notebook, 1 folder and 1 pencil supply pouch. This is only a started supply kit and will be in your child’s classroom waiting for them.

9. What is the Dress Code? Do I need to purchase Uniforms for my child?

Davie Elementary does not require students to wear uniforms. We highly encourage students to show school spirit by wearing Davie Elementary T-Shirts. The T-Shirt Order Form to purchase T-Shirts will be online soon. All students at Davie Elementary are required to follow the Code of Student Conduct guidelines as it pertains to school dress code.
