## ● EXPECTATIONS AT SCHOOL

- Students need to **arrive ready** for school.
- All students will bring their backpacks, with all needed folders and papers back to school
- EVERY DAY!
- When students are **absent**, parents need to **contact the front office, report the absence online**, or write a letter to the teacher to excuse the absence. You will have 48 hours to report your child's absence.
- We will teach and practice **school behavior**. As information concerning this goes home, please reinforce the school and class rules.

  - **Responsibility**
  - **Respect**



# ATTENDANCE

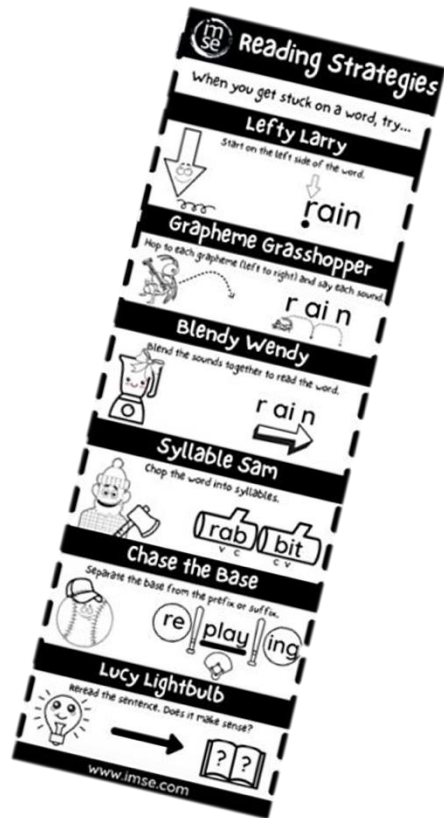
- School day starts promptly at **8:00 AM** and ends at **2:00 PM**
- Both excused and unexcused absences along with tardiness and early sign-outs will be counted when determining a student's pattern of non-attendance
- Each time your child is absent you are required to notify the school, either by telephone or through a note, within 48 hours stating the reason for the absence. If the school is not notified the absence is considered unexcused.

- Should be read multiple times for mastery
- Adult should ask 1 or 2 questions as a comprehension check



# WHY READ 20 MINUTES AT HOME?

Student A Reads	Student B Reads	Student C Reads
❖ 20 minutes per day.	❖ 5 minutes per day.	❖ 1 minute per day
❖ 3,600 minutes per school year.	❖ 900 minutes per school year.	❖ 180 minutes per school year.
❖ 1,800,000 words per year.	❖ 282,000 words per year.	❖ 8,000 words per year.
		
❖ Scores in the 90 <sup>th</sup> percentile on standardized tests.	❖ Scores in the 50 <sup>th</sup> percentile on standardized tests.	❖ Scores in the 10 <sup>th</sup> percentile on standardized tests.

If they start reading for 20 minutes per night in Kindergarten, by the end of 6<sup>th</sup> grade, Student A will have read for the equivalent of 60 school days, Student B will have read for 12 school days, and Student C will have read for 3.

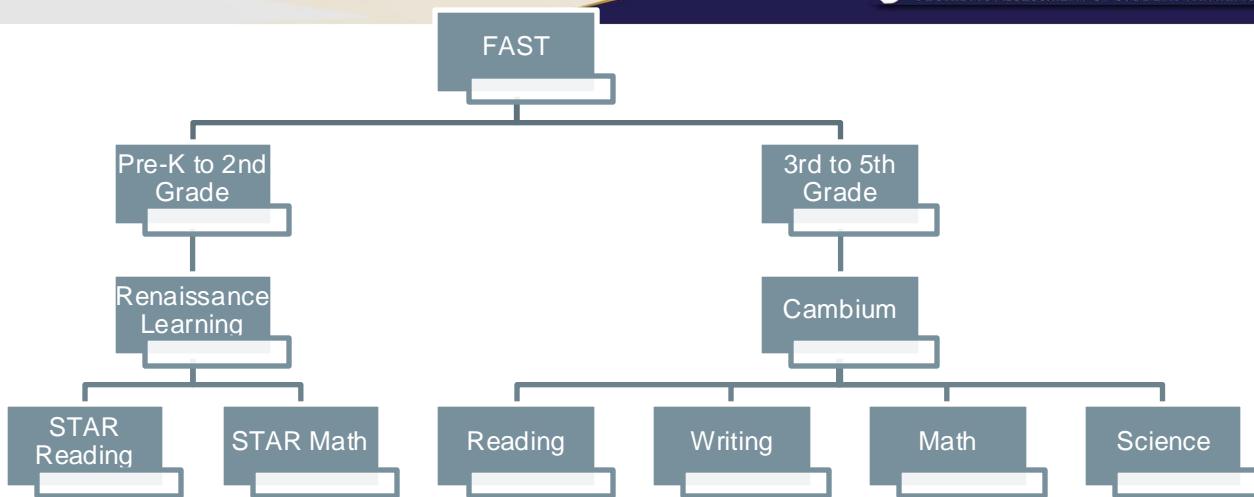
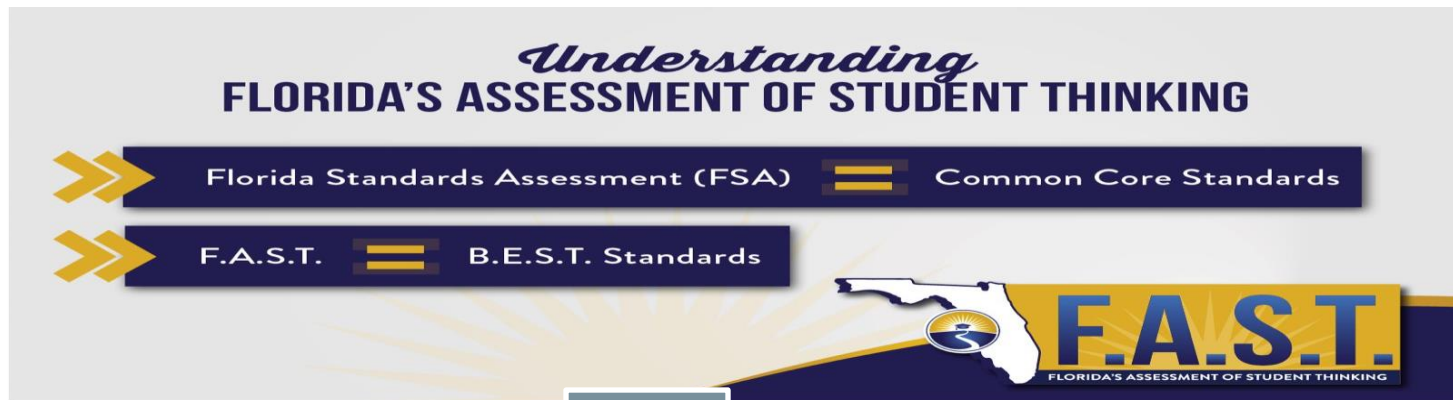
# i-Ready

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# HOMework

- Homework is important to each student's educational experience:
  - Reinforce skills taught in the classroom
  - Provide the student with an opportunity for independent practice
    - Study classroom materials
  - Explore and master skills more thoroughly than class time allows
    - Encourages responsibility, study skills, and self-discipline
- Homework will be given Monday through Thursday.
- School board policy 10 minutes per grade level
- Make-up Work: For every absence, the student is allowed 2 school days





# Folders/Communication

## Homework (Colored Folders)

- Go home on Monday and Returned Friday.
- UFLI Home Sheet (Phonics) and Reading
- Daily Math Review



## Red Folders (Harbordale logo)

- Go home on Tuesday and Returned Wednesday.
- Return any important papers
- Homework will go home.

- Due to liability issues, preschool children are not permitted to accompany volunteers in the classrooms when assisting or on field trips.

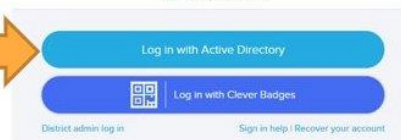


# CLEVER

4. Enter your birthday as the password in the MM/DD/YYYY format. Be sure to include a capital P to begin.

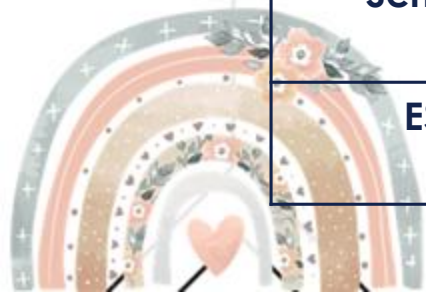
