Make-up Work: For every absence, the student is allowed 2 school days


GRADING DOLLGY

In Second grade we use a 1, 2, 3, grading system. These numbers do not equate to A, B, C's... They are strictly based on your child's ability to complete the standard:

Receiving a 1 means, your Child has <u>mastered a skill</u>, <u>independently</u>

2 Child <u>is on target</u> for mastering the skill, <u>with some</u> <u>assistance</u>

3 Area of Concern- Your child is <u>not meeting the</u> <u>expectation</u>, we are focusing to improve on this skill

- Working snack, please provide something quick that does not require a spoon.






