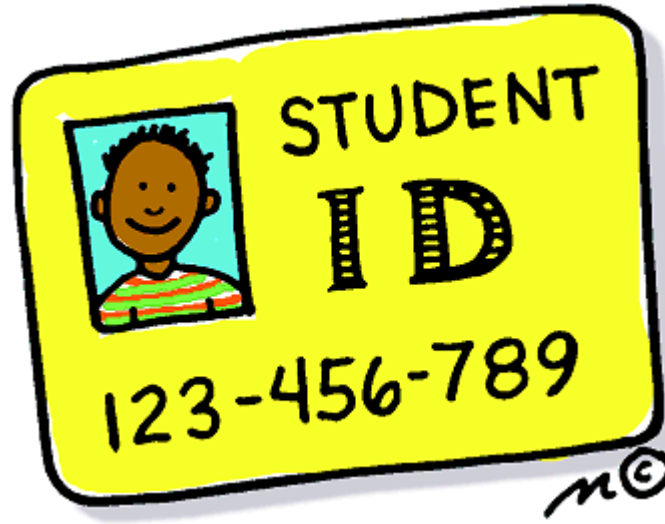


Film Club is back and welcoming new members! Join us for our meetings every Monday from 8:45 to 9:15am in room #106.
