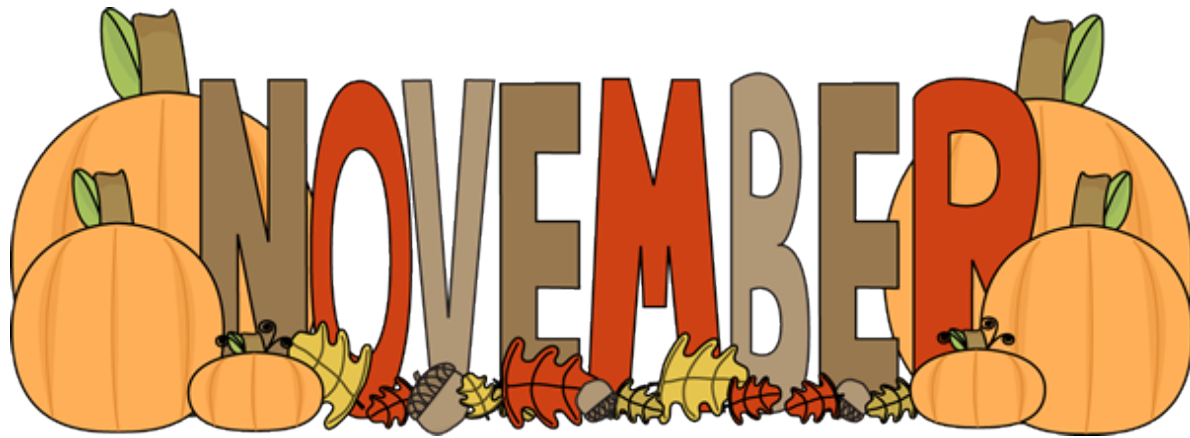

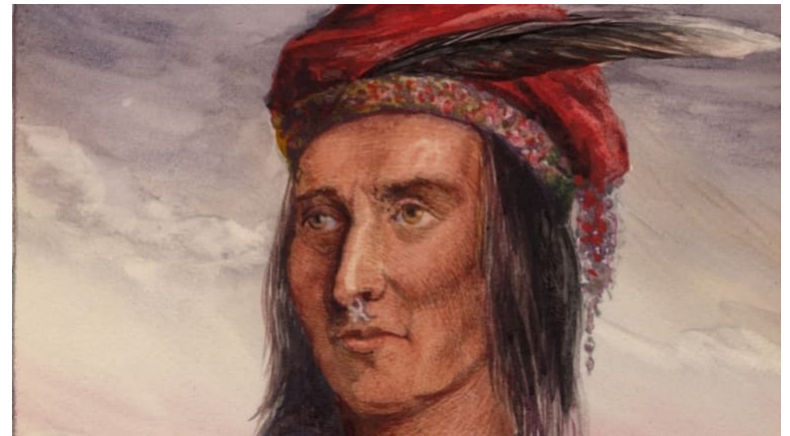
CELEBRITY BIRTHDAYS!

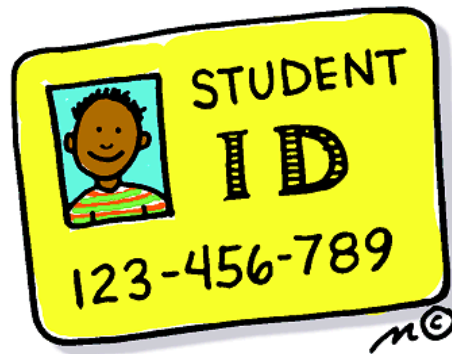
Candy sales will be every Thursday, located in the breezeway and café!! Candy is only \$2 each, come get your candy!
